For the past five years, God has honored this passion by allowing me to serve North American Missions, UPCI as the Director of Education. OUR DNA


In over 40 years of ministry, my wife Ann and I have given our lives to planting churches, pastoring, mentoring, and training. Church planting was infused into my spiritual DNA by my parents who left the comfort of an established church to be a founding family in a new church plant. They taught home Bible studies, and on Sundays filled our station wagon with people to bring to church. By our late teens, my siblings and I started a bus ministry outreach on Saturdays. On Sundays, we filled the bus with children for Sunday School. After Bible College, I got involved in a new church plant and I married Ann, my gift from God and marvelous co-adventurer! Together we taught Bible studies, beheld miracles, and saw conversions. Bible studies turned into a group, and the group turned into a church. The rest is history.

WHAT IS A FORWARD MISSIONARY?

Just as in Metro Missions, where an extraordinary effort is required to reach urban areas, Forward Missions is an extraordinary effort to reach uber-rural areas. What does Forward Missions look like? It looks like the funding of an experienced church planter, with a full-time focus, to establish multiple churches throughout a region.

WHY THE ROCKY MOUNTAIN DISTRICT (MONTANA, WYOMING, UTAH)?

- There are 38 churches, in three states, covering 330,000 square miles (10%+ of the continental USA) with a population of 5.2 Million.
- This region is targeted by North American Missions as under-evangelized.





WHY SOUTHWEST MONTANA?

- This region is 3x's the size of the State of Connecticut with one established church and one NAM church.
- SW Montana has a large population concentration.
- SW Montana is experiencing rapid growth.



WHY FORWARD MISSIONS (CIRCUIT RIDING MODEL)?

- It is a Biblical method:
 - "Jesus went about the villages in a circuit, teaching" (Mark 6:6 NKJV).
 - Paul's method in the Book of Acts.
 - John's seven churches circuit of Asia (Revelation 1-3).
- The Second Great Awakening was also marked by circuit riders.

WITH YOUR HELP, THESE REGIONS CAN BE REACHED

We are experienced church planters in both rural and urban areas. Our mentors and advisors have been with us every step of the way.

Opposition awaits. We are headed into the Wild West, where people are self-made and have a spirit of independence. The cities of Butte and Anaconda have dark pasts. Bozeman boasts eclectic prosperity, while West Yellowstone faces isolation. We will stand on Jesus' assertion in Matthew 16:18-19. With God, you, and us, the Kingdom will be expanded!

Our Plan:

- Utilize personal prayer and fasting.
- Establish prayer partners.
- · Consult spiritual advisors.
- Obtain financial supporters.
- Pray up, build, and train a team(s).
- Frequently attend places within the seven targeted communities to make connections > develop friendships > teach Home Bible Studies > see conversions > continue to disciple > develop leaders > appoint leaders, and release leaders into ministry.
- Journal all processes experienced for future circuit riders.

- Focus on County Seats (influential government centers): Bozeman, Butte, Dillon, Livingston.
