<u>Reporting Abuse.</u> Any incident causing belief that a child's or youth's physical or emotional welfare has been or may be adversely affected by abuse or neglect by any person, will be immediately reported to the coordinator/chair in charge of the event.

The persons in charge of the activity, event, or ministry and/or the person witnessing the incident will immediately suspend and/or remove the alleged abuser from any contact with children or youth, including any duties that involve children or youth, pending internal and external investigation of the incident. The persons in charge of the activity, event or ministry will immediately inform the child's parents of the incident, and then the SEJ Coordinator and event coordinator will notify the appropriate legal and state authorities pursuant to T.C.A. 37-1-605 and 37-1-613. The Coordinator will notify the District Superintendent or the Bishop of the area as appropriate to the situation.
