PROSTATE BIOPSY INSTRUCTIONS

Before your biopsy:

- Tell your doctor if you are taking Aspirin, Plavix, Coumadin, Eliquis, Pradaxa, Xarelto, Aggrenox, Motrin, Ibuprofen, Advil, Excedrin or any NSAID type medication or any Vitamins as you <u>MUST STOP</u> THEM 7 DAYS BEFORE YOUR BIOPSY
- Continue all other medications unless you are told otherwise
- Tell your doctor if you are not feeling well the day of your biopsy, or you have blood in your urine or pain when you urinate
- Pick up your antibiotic prescription to be ready for your biopsy

The day of the biopsy:

- Start taking the antibiotic: the first pill the morning of your biopsy and the second the night of your biopsy
- Make sure you eat breakfast or lunch. Do not fast. It is a good idea to bring juice/ snack afterwards
- It is suggested someone drives you back, but it is not necessary

After the biopsy:

- Take the antibiotic at night
- You can take Tylenol 500 mg every 4 hours if you need it for pain
- Do not restart your blood thinners until YOU NO LONGER SEE BLOOD ANYWHERE
- Do not do any heavy lifting/ exercise/ sexual activity for 2-3 days
- It is normal to have blood in the stool for up to a week, blood in the urine for 1-2 weeks, blood in the semen for 4-6 weeks, some mild irritation when you urinate
- We will have your results in 1-2 weeks and we will have a follow up appointment then to discuss in detail

It is not normal if you have any of this. If so, please contact us:

- If you have fever > 101, nausea, vomiting, you cannot urinate, the urine looks like ketchup, you feel dizzy or have pain in your chest, the burning/ pain or blood does not improve, you have a lot of blood clots in the urine and it is difficult to urinate
