Health & Fire Regulations:

Provincial health regulations that may be in effect at time of show will be followed.

As per fire regulations protocol alley ways <u>MUST</u> be clear at all times, this means no tacking up/cross tying, no class prep, no chairs, tack, tables, hay, shavings etc.

Show Arena & Warm Up Access: The show arena and warm up area will be available at 12 noon, Thursday, October 10. If you want to ride or exercise your horse prior to this time, you will need to make arrangements with the Keystone Centre and pay their rental fee.

DOGS:

As per Keystone Centre rules, all dogs must be kept on leash and under control at all times. No dogs are allowed in the WACE show arena at any time.

STABLING:

No unauthorized use of empty stalls for storage, temporary use or day use. Violators will be charged with additional stall rental.

VENDORS/THERAPLATES:

To book a spot for a Vendor Trade Booth or a Theraplate, please call Show Manager, Sharon Forbes-Hanks 204-825-7055.

For safety reasons, Theraplates must be situated within a stall and must be booked in advance to be situated near a safe power source

WALK/TROT CLASSES:

Rules for AQHA Walk/Trot Classes shall be followed as per section SHW755 of the AQHA Rulebook.

LEVEL 1 CLASSES:

Sections 245, 246, 250, 251 & 252 as per the AQHA Rulebook shall be followed.

ALL BREED SMALL FRY 12 & UNDER WALK/TROT:

Exhibitors entered in this division may not cross enter into the AQHA Youth division. However, if there is a horse being used in an AQHA division (Open, Amateur or Youth), it may be entered into the All Breed Small Fry with another exhibitor, and by paying an additional \$10/class/judge up to a maximum of \$100 in addition to their other division fee. NOTE: Small Fry Western Pleasure and Horsemanship classes will be held back-to-back along with Small Fry Hunter Under Saddle and Hunt Seat Equitation.

MQHA/AQHA/MHC MEMBERSHIPS:

Manitoba Quarter Horse Association memberships and AQHA memberships may be purchased at the Show Office. Exhibitors must have a current MHC or provincial equivalent if out of province.
