General Information

HAUL-IN, STALL FEES & SHAVINGS:

All horses must either pay stall or ground fees.

Haul-In fee per day: \$10.00

Horses may be tied to trailer during day only.

Box & Tack Stalls:

Circuit (2 nights) \$90.00 1 Night \$60.00

Extra Night Fee to Stay Until Monday \$25.00 If participant in clinic, Sunday night stall included in clinic fee.

Shavings: Must be Pre-booked \$11.00 per bale Please note shavings are not self-serve. Orders for additional bales at the show must be placed through the Show Office.

Empty Stalls: No unauthorized use of empty stalls for storage, temporary use or day use. Violators will be charged with additional stall rental.

NOTE: <u>DO NOT</u> change stall assignments. This can only be done by the Secretary or Show Manager. MQHA/AQHA/MHC MEMBERSHIPS: Manitoba Quarter Horse Association memberships and AQHA memberships may be purchased at the Show Office. ALL exhibitors must have a current MHC or provincial equivalent if out of province.

ARRIVAL TIME:

Horses may arrive any time after 12 noon on Friday, August 2, 2024. Stall charts and Camping charts will be posted at the East end of the barns. Please note that if you arrive late at night, the barns may be locked. If that occurs, you can call the Security number posted on the doors for them to let you in.

SHOW ARENA & WARM UP ACCESS:

The show arena and warm up area will be available at 12 noon, on Friday, August 2, 2024

DOGS:

As per MHC and MB Provincial Park rules, all dogs must be kept on leash and under control at all times. Dogs are not allowed in any buildings on MHC Facility, including barns.

(Includes: office fees & entry fees). If you show in
more than 4 classes/judge per division the AllInclusive Fee shall be applied. Does not include paid
warm up for all-around trail

Paid Warm Ups (all categories, including All-Breed)

Trail (All – Around & Ranch) \$10.00/horse Trail Warm Up Fee is applicable to every horse showing trail in the All-Around Division & Ranch including Youth.

OFFICE FEES:

Office Charge: \$20.00/horse/judge AQHA Processing Fee: \$15.00/horse/ judge

Office fees included in Flat Fees for AQHA & All-Breed. AQHA fees are <u>not</u> included in Flat Fee. If cross entering individual classes in VRH & AQHA divisions then both fees must be paid as they are recognized as separate shows by AQHA.

VRH Information

Office Charge: \$20.00/horse/judge
AQHA Processing Fee: \$18.00/horse/judge
Individual Class Fee: \$20.00/class/horse

AQHA processing fee must be paid if entering an individual class. If cross entering individual classes in VRH & AQHA divisions the AQHA fee must be paid as they are recognized as separate shows by AQHA.

ALL-BREED DIVISION FEES

This division is open to all-breeds and all riders. No cross entry between horse/rider in AQHA and VRH classes.

Youth 18 & Under:

Open 19 & Over:

Individual Classes: \$15.00/class/judge
Open 19 & Over All Inclusive fee: \$150.00/horse
(Includes: office fees & entry fees). If you show in
more than 4 classes/judge per division the AllInclusive Fee shall be applied. Does not include paid
warm up for all-around trail

Small-Fry 12 & Under - Walk/Jog Only

No office fees. No class fees.

Lead Line Class - free to enter AQHA/All Breed

OFFICE FEES:

Office Charge: \$20.00/horse/judge Office fees included in Flat Fees for All-Breed.

SMALL FRY 12 & UNDER - WALK/JOG

Exhibitors entered in this division may not cross enter into the AQHA Youth division or All-Breed Youth division. However, if there is a horse being used in an AQHA division (Open, Amateur or Youth) or All Breed division, it may be entered into the Small Fry with another exhibitor.

BARREL JACKPOT - ALL AGES \$10/run 100% of entry fees goes into the jackpot. Payouts dependent on entries.



Auditors can sign up at the show or day of clinic.

The perspective the Kapushion's bring: Marvin and Sue compete and train for a variety of events such as Roping, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure, Working Cowhorse, Reining, Over Fence classes and Trail just to name a few and have qualified and competed at the World and National level in all these events. They have shown over 40 horses successfully in the top 15 at the World or Nationals in Quarter Horse, Appaloosa and Paint.

Sue is an AQHA, ApHC, APHA and NSBA accredited judge and has judged the Appaloosa Nationals three times, the Appaloosa World Championships, the Australian Nationals, German Nationals and the All American Paint Horse Congress, and the Paint Horse World Championships.

Marvin is an accredited AQHA, ApHC, APHA, ApHC and NSBA judge having judged such shows as the prestigious Redbud circuit in Oklahoma City, the Appaloosa Nationals, the All American Paint horse Congress and the Paint Horse World Championships.

High Point AQHA Ranch Horse (all divisions) may show in the following AQHA classes: Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding and Working Western Rail. This will be a combined total of all divisions/classes per horse/rider combo. No horse may cross enter a western pleasure or walk/trot western pleasure and ranch riding class at the same show regardless of division (youth, amateur, select or open). This also applies to the working western rail class. No horse may cross enter a trail class or walk/trot trail class and ranch trail at the same show regardless of division (youth, amateur, select or open)

Horses must show in 4 All-Breed class categories in the respective division to be eligible for the High Point Circuit Award.
