**July 21 - \$175 per student**

**8:00 AM - 5:00 PM**

**Canine Behavior and Aggressive Dogs** – This course will offer ACO's a basic understanding of dog behaviors in a field environment, assisting ACO's to recognize and respond to hazardous situations associated with dangerous or potentially dangerous dogs.

**Challenging Encounters in Animal Control** - This class covers strategies for dealing with everything from activists to elected officials with stops for "hoarders", animal welfare groups and administrators. **Community Cooperation- Outreach and Education** - This instruction offers tips, guidelines and information on developing and speaking for a variety of functions and organizations. **Diversion – Alternative Enforcement Programs** - This course offers students a variety of innovative ideas that provide revenue enhancement, improved license compliance and alternatives to traditional citations.

**Interpersonal Communications** – This training offers practical tools and strategies for improving an ACO's verbal and nonverbal communication skills. **Officer Safety and Protection** – This course will offer an understanding of the principles of officer safety in an animal care and control environment.

**Safe Animal Handling/Capture and Restraint Equipment** – This course will offer concepts and procedures for safely capturing and handling a variety of species of animals and will discuss animal handling equipment along with **Control-Pole Training**, a class that covers the catch pole, its use and proper animal handling. **Stress Management Compassion Fatigue** - This course will discuss the impact of stress, to include, offering methods on how to minimize or eliminate certain stressors commonly affecting animal control/care workers. **Sovereign Citizens** – Students will be exposed to the tactics, philosophy and actions of the Sovereign Citizen movement including how to identify involved individuals.

**July 24 - \$225.00 for each certification or \$450.00 per student for both**

**Lifting and Loading Certification (8:00 AM to 12:00 PM)** - Students will be given instruction on body mechanics, safety, individual lifting techniques, team lifting techniques, alternatives to lifting, loading & transporting techniques, and mechanical assistance options. **Oleoresin Capsicum (OCAT) Certification (1:00 PM to 5:00 PM)** The course provides instruction and training in the proper use of OCAT spray.

**July 25 - \$225.00 per person**

**Chemical Immobilization** – This course will discuss the principles for using chemicals to tranquilize and capture animals, the drugs used in such captures, the devices used to deliver the sedatives, and more.
