



2021 Hall Of Fame Nomination Form

Eligibility for Nomination

The Animal Control Hall of Fame celebrates industry legends, who, throughout their trailblazing careers, have distinguished themselves with outstanding, nationally- and statewide-recognized professional achievements; remarkable innovations that have changed our industry and our culture; and exceptional work both within the Animal Control industry and in our communities. Any individual associated with the Animal Control profession whose significant contribution changed the industry in a positive manner is eligible for consideration. This includes Animal Control Officers, supervisors and directors, currently employed or retired, living or deceased. Members of the ACCA Selection Committee are ineligible.

Selection Criteria

Inductees into the ACHF should exemplify key guiding principles. Commentary and supporting documentation that demonstrate the depth and scope of the nominee's specific contributions should be included. A candidate must have a minimum of 10 years of service to the Animal Control profession, and can be nominated based upon one or all of the following criteria:

- Leadership - The candidate was involved with an outstanding project or idea that has had a dynamic and lasting effect on the profession.
- Exemplary Dedication - The nominee manages or works in an Animal Control-related agency or a Humane Society, serving in an outstanding and exemplary manner, promoting a positive image of the Animal Control profession and having positive relations with the community, i.e., performing services for the community above and beyond the services for which they were hired.
- Recognition and Achievements - The candidate, based upon their service career, has been recognized for their professional and personal commitment.
- The nominee is an innovator who created a product or service that has had a significant and lasting effect on the Animal Control profession.

Guidelines for a Successful Nomination

Complete this nomination form. Please include supporting documentation of the nominee's achievements (newspaper/magazine/web articles, recommendation letters, accomplishments and honors, etc.). Describe your nominee and their accomplishments as if you are presenting the award to that person.

Make your nominee stand out with specific details about their contributions. Every effort should be made to provide examples, which attest to the criteria.

Nomination Process
