
An innovative platform that empowers young individuals to audition, perform, direct, and produce their own shows.

In partnership with Broadway Bound Kids, BBK Rocks is a three-week Pop/Rock performance intensive offered completely tuition free for students grades 7th-12th. This program has been created for students who possess a passion for Pop/Rock music, but lack access to training.

Teaching Artists will work with students on Pop/Rock performances customized to each student's creative aesthetic, and will collaboratively create two group numbers. We will build community in our classes while working towards creating a final product, and offer a chance for our students to grow their relationships with music!







In partnership with Jazzheads, R.O.B. records stands as PATH Fund's exclusive record label. Our label empowers artists to write, produce, record, and launch their own music.




