

Final Cinderella Reminders!

Dancers MUST arrive at dress rehearsal at 4pm

Schedule:

Thursday, January 22nd

4pm - Dancers arrive at the theater with hair and make-up already done. Please park at the civic center and enter through the side stage door. The front doors of the theatre will be locked.

We will take roll, do hair and make-up checks, and warm up before rehearsal begins.

5-8pm - Dress rehearsal **(Parents may watch from the audience but please do not post photos or videos of rehearsals on social media)**

Friday, January 23rd

8:30am - Dancers arrive with hair and make-up done (Flower Girls/Pre-Ballet excluded)

9:30am - School performance

11am - Lunch (Dancers will stay at the theatre during lunch break)

12:30pm - School performance

1:30pm - Cast Photo (Optional for Flower girls/Pre-Ballet)

6pm - Dancers arrive with hair and make-up done

(Flower Girls/Pre-ballet may arrive at 7pm OR sit in the audience for ACTS 1 & 2)

7pm - Gala Performance

Saturday, January 24th

1:30pm - Dancers arrive with hair and make-up done


(Flower Girls/Pre-ballet may arrive at 2:30pm OR sit in the audience for ACTS 1 & 2)

2:30 pm - Matinee Performance

Theatre Rules:

- We will have 2 designated backstage moms for levels 1 and older. Pre-Ballet and Ballet K moms may come to the **dressing rooms** to help your dancers with costumes.
- Dancers should always have on regular clothing or a cover up when they are in the audience or lobby, unless instructed to sell programs in costume, etc. Otherwise, **NO costumes** should be worn outside of the dressing rooms or stage area until the show is over.
- NO videos or photos of dress rehearsal should be posted on social media.
- NO eating or applying make-up in costumes.
- Costumes will be at the theatre. Please leave costumes hanging up at the side of the stage after the final show.
- Dancers should be on their best behavior while in the theatre. No running or horseplaying.
- Backstage moms will be responsible for making sure their class maintains proper theater etiquette.

Hair and Make-Up info 

LEVEL	HAIR	MAKE-UP
Pre-Ballet & Ballet K	<p>-Slicked back ballet bun in line with the top of the ears (lower than the crown) with a hair net, bobby pins, hair spray</p> 	<p>-Pink blush -Pink lipstick -Black Mascara</p> 
Level 1/2/3	<p>-Low ballet bun at the nape of the neck, parted on the left with a hair net, bobby pins, hair spray</p> 	<p>-Powder -Pink Blush -Brown eyeshadows -Black eyeliner (top and bottom) -Black Mascara -Natural red lipstick -Mice will need a pink nose and 3 black whiskers (backstage moms can help with this if needed)</p> 
Level 4/5	<p>-Low ballet bun at the nape of the neck, parted on the left with a hair net, bobby pins, hair spray</p>	<p>-Foundation -Contour -Powder -Pink Blush -Brown eyeshadows -Black eyeliner (top and bottom with 1 wing) -False eyelashes -Black Mascara -Natural red lipstick -Diamond stud earrings</p>

- NO nail polish
- NO glitter
- NO lotion
- NO jewelry of any kind (permanent jewelry must be covered with bandaides/skin toned medical tape)
- NO sock buns, donut buns, or bun makers of any kind
- Please make sure you have a nice new pair of pink tights and pink ballet shoes
- No undergarments should be worn other than tights and a nude leotard if needed
