Minutes of previous meeting have been accepted.

Financial status

- We presently have \$9241.66 in the bank and a \$ 500 deposit was made for next year's golf tournament.

Board Membership

- The club needs to recruit more persons in the Club (preferably in the workforce).
- We have many vacancies to fill and need some 4 or 5.
- Guy plans to resign from his role as President because he has been president for about 15 years and he does not know many people in CRA anymore.
- He is prepared to stay as Director after a replacement is found and to ensure a smooth transition.

Visibility of the Generations Club

- The club would like our Champion to send a message within the CRA.
- The club is not succeeding in reaching its intended audience for its activities.
- Discussions followed about how to reach NCR audiences as working arrangements now allow for employees to be out of NCR and still work with HQ.

- Our intended messages may reach employees outside NCR.
- Regions may want to create local chapters and the Club would facilitate if there is any interest.

- Our Treasurer indicated that none of the transactions cycled through our bank account.

Cruise and fireworks

- First event for the club using Eventbrite.
 - Fees of about 10% of face ticket price.
 - o Money was directly deposited weekly by Eventbrite in our BMO bank account.
 - o Initial set up was a bit complex but all went smooth.
- The club used to have a waiting list with a max of 200 participants. It was decided to reduce the number of participants to 175 and we struggled this year to break even.
- A discussion was had to decide to repeat or not this activity next year.
 - It was decided to repeat this event for next year but to try to better reach our intended audience of participants.
 - We need to first confirm if there are any spots we can reserve for next year.
 - It was concluded that the club could risk manage a \$500 deposit to reserve a spot for next year.
