Welcome new members

Guy Proulx welcomed the new members Suzanne Hess and Laurie Drake and expressed his appreciation for their interest in furthering the club's interests.

Postmortem golf tournament

Heather Daniels organized the tournament and indicated there were 156 participants. The financial report was shared with members a while back and indicated that the event broke even. There were 3 draws made yielding 625 back to the winners. Door prizes were given including those provided by the Meadows Gold Club. The event is booked again for next year at Meadows golf course in early June. This event was most successful and weather did cooperate.

Cruise event of August 12th

This is the first event organized on the Eventbrite platform. The committee is composed of Guy, Lisa and Joanne. Price is set at 40\$ to cover Eventbrite costs of some 4\$ thereby yielding a net revenue of 36\$ to the club to cover expenses including the cruise, disco and munchies. Capacity was set at 180 and 175 tickets are available to the general public.

Executive members can purchase tickets for 36\$ each and save the Eventbrite processing fees of 4\$. It was also agreed that there would not be any draws as the club does not need the money

and it is a chore to do while folks are dancing or enjoying fireworks and also because fewer people carry cash.

Tickets will first be offered to our registered members and Sheila can release event info after the meeting as tickets go on sale on July 8th. The event will next be publicized by Heather on our Facebook site on July 15th. We will then determine if there is a need to reach within CRA based on tickets sold a few weeks before the event. The organizers will make that decision.

New website
