<i>Tattered Journal</i>	book *interactive	A tattered journal. Some pages seem so worn with time, the pencil entries are illegible.	A journal with a torn cover and loose, yellowed pages. Only the last half of the entries are legible– the rest are worn and smudged, as though eroded by years of time. *can flip through pages	BEFORE OPENING: “This looks promising. Wonder if there are any clues inside.” AFTER OPENING: “Wow, this is... old. It seems like whenever they ran out of pages, they went back and started cramming their thoughts into the margins. Hardly any of it is legible, but what I can read seems... scattered. They must have been here a long time.”	
<i>“In the Bishop’s Tower”</i>	item	A book about the adventures of an escaped prince. Seems oddly clean considering where it was found.	The back of the book describes the harrowing journey of a deposed prince and his escape from captivity and the political machinations of his enemies. Hardback, embossed cover.	*randomized bark	
<i>“Oh, to Sail Away”</i>	item	A paperback book someone used to practice their handwriting... The vandal’s penmanship seems greatly improved towards the later pages.	A paperback book with a watercolor picture of a boat on the open sea. The contents are mostly illegible; the margins are filled to the brim with copied words and practiced letters. The original story is illegible.	“I remember this book– one of my favorites as a kid. Looks like someone drew all over it.”	
<i>Soiled Facility Uniform</i>	clothing	A worn and dirty outfit that has seen better days. The style seems a little outdated.		“Gross. I’m not touching that.”	
<i>Tattered Drawings</i>	book *interactive	Fifty or so drawings on mismatched pages– all bound together with scraps of cloth and string. Despite the decades of difference between the first and last papers, they all seem to have been drawn on by the same person... just like the Tattered Journal.	A poorly bound, patchwork collection of paper filled to the brim with nonsensical drawings. Flipping through them, it seems the initial pages are aged and fragile, but the later pages appear almost new. *can flip through pages	*randomized bark
