FRIENDLY REMINDERS:

- City Hall will be closed on May 25, 2026, in observance of Memorial Day and June 19, 2026 in observance of Juneteenth.

You can now pay your utility bill online with Paystar. From the City's website you can get directed to Paystar where you can see and pay your current utility bill. Paystar has the ability to set up automatic payments as well as being able to go paperless. To log into your account you just need to know your account number and use the first 3 letters of your name. Using Paystar you will be able to see your bill the day they are made up and not have to wait for them to come in the mail. It will also allow you to see the most current update of your bill.
