- **City Hall:** City Hall will be closed May 26 in honor of Memorial Day.
- **Local Option Tax:** The City of Harrison imposes a local option tax (LOT) on lodging rentals, liquor by the drink, prepared meals, and all taxable retail sales. To conduct sales within the City of Harrison, a business must apply Local-Option Non-Property Tax Permit.
- **Open Burning:** Burning of paper, grass, brush, lumber or other burnable refuse shall be prohibited between June 1 and September 30 unless a burning permit is issued. The burning of paper, grass, brush, lumber or other burnable refuse shall be permitted without a permit between October 1 and May 31.

MEMO FROM THE MAYOR

Spring is in full bloom, and our Public Works Crew has been hard at work preparing for the busy season ahead! We're thrilled to announce that the City has received four grants in addition to the \$9,691,435 Wastewater Grant and \$1,608,000 dollar Drinking Water grant

- **Transportation Alternatives Program** – \$500,000 *A representative from LHTAC will visit the City on May 21, 2025, to discuss this grant and what it means for our community.*
- **Drinking Water Contaminants Grant** – \$2,880,000 *This grant will assist in the removal of iron and manganese, improving water quality for our community.*
- **Curb Grant** – \$56,000 *This grant will assist in new ADA Curb Grants on our sidewalks*
- **Child Pedestrian Grant** – \$250,000 *This grant will help enhance the safety and well-being of our children.*
