Fall Cleanup Reminder:

Residents of Harrison, please be mindful of city ordinances while using the streets and parking areas.

- Trailers/Boats: Must be attached to a vehicle if on public streets or property (City Code 5—2-42)
- Obstructions: No itmes like lumber, logs, or machinery may obstruct streets or avenues (City Code 3-2-3A)
- Garbage: No garbage or rubbish containers should be placed in alleys (City Code 3-1-3B2)
- Inoperable Vehicles: It's unlawful to leave wrecked or dismantled vehicles on public streets for more than 48 hours.
