1% Local Option Tax Due Date: The 1% Local Option Tax is due on the 20th of each month. Please ensure that all necessary forms are submitted by this date to avoid and penalties or delays.

Opt-Out Information for Commercial Businesses: If you are a commercial business and wish to opt out of the City's sanitation services and prefer to contract with individual businesses independently, please inform the City Clerk by October 10, 2024.
