

CITY OF HARRISON ORDINANCE NO. 498

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HARRISON, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, REPEALING 1983 Code § 8.12.100 CODIFIED AS MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 3, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 4, OPEN BURNING. REVISING A REQUIREMENT THAT ALL OPEN BURNING WITHIN THE CITY SHALL REQUIRE A VALID BURN PERMIT ISSUED BY THE ST. MARIES FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT; PROVIDING THAT BURN PERMITS MAY BE OBTAINED THROUGH THE ST. MARIES FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT WEBSITE OR AT HARRISON CITY HALL; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE UPON PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Harrison Finds it is in the Best Interest of the Public Health, Safety, And Welfare to Update Regulations Pertaining to Open Burning Within the City; And

WHEREAS, The City Council Desires to Repeal the Existing 1983 Code § 8.12.100 Codified as Municipal Code Section Title 3, Chapter 2, Section 4, Open Burning and Require Compliance with the Permitting Process Administered by the St. Maries Fire Protection District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: 1983 § CODE 8.12.100, codified as Municipal Code Title 3, Chapter 2, Section 4 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Harrison which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: Severability: This ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. Should any portion of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect and shall be read to carry out the purpose(s) of the ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.

SECTION 4: Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.

PASSED by the City Council under suspension of the rules upon a roll call vote of 4 ayes, 0 nays and APPROVED by the Mayor on the 11 day of August, 2026.
