

Port fuel injection sprays fuel into the intake port just before the intake valve, so the service is aimed at cleaning the fuel rail, injectors, intake tract, and related air/fuel components without damaging the system.

Before You Start

- **Confirm the vehicle actually has port fuel injection, not direct injection or diesel. Port-injection service methods are different from direct-injection systems.**
- **Work in a well-ventilated area, keep away from open flames, and wear safety glasses.**
- **Make sure the engine has no active overheating condition, fuel leaks, or unusual knocking before starting.**
- **Follow the service equipment instructions for the cleaner tool you are using, since pressure settings and connection points vary by system.**

Tools and Supplies

- **Fuel system cleaning kit or pressurized induction/fuel-rail cleaning tool.**
- **Justice Brothers fuel injector cleaner for the service tool.**
- **Basic hand tools.**
- **Safety glasses and gloves.**
- **Shop air source if the tool requires it.**
- **Scan tool if available, to monitor engine temperature and trouble codes.**
