

Intake And Air Side

A complete fuel service often includes cleaning the throttle body and, when appropriate, the mass airflow sensor with the correct sensor-safe cleaner. If the air inlet duct, throttle plate, or intake tract is dirty, cleaning those parts helps restore airflow and complements the injector cleaning. Refit everything carefully afterward so there are no vacuum leaks or loose connections.

Final Checks

- **Start the engine and confirm smooth idle.**
- **Check for fuel odors or leaks around the rail, line, and service port.**
- **Road test the vehicle and verify normal acceleration and no warning lights.**
- **Re-scan for codes if a scan tool is available.**
