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Flight Expo's Build A Plane Safety Rules

Your son/daughter, _____ is enrolled in Flight Expo's Build A Plane program; An introduction to Aviation Technology, Building Construction, Sheet Metal, Materials & Processes, Welding, Riveting, Drilling. This courses does require the use of equipment and material. Students will be given information and demonstrations on the appropriate use and handling of the equipment and material. Precautions are taken to prevent accidents, however hands on does have a higher risk of an accident occurring. We want this to be a positive and safe experience for your son/daughter.

The following safety rules must be observed at all times throughout the year in the program.

Behavior:

1. No use of the building or equipment unless directed by instructor.
2. No food or drink – only at break time (about 6:40 pm on Tuesday nights, 10:30 am on Saturday mornings)
3. No horseplay.
4. Do not enter storage or office areas without permission or directed by the instructor.
5. No Cell phones, ear buds, watch ipads etc. unless directed by a instructor.
6. Do not lean on aircrafts or handle props on the aircrafts unless instructed by the instructor.
7. Tools are not a toy! Do not point them at anyone or play with them.
8. Listen and be quiet during information/direction from instructor.
9. Contact the instructor with any questions about what they would like you to work on, or if your need further explanation or additional projects.
10. Respect other students/adult projects.

Knowledge/Skills

1. Use common sense and caution; be aware of what is around you.
2. Utilize all safety equipment and wear appropriate clothing.
3. Only use materials and equipment (unless otherwise authorized) by the instructor.
4. Report any problems with equipment to the instructor immediately.
5. All accidents and injuries must be reported to the instructor immediately.
6. Use the proper techniques that the instructor demonstrated

Organization

1. Keep your work area neat, clean and organized.
2. Safety glasses must be worn at all time in the building.
3. Return all equipment to its proper storage area prior to leaving for the night/day.
4. Keep all floors, aisles, and doorways free of obstructions.
5. Know the location of all emergency safety equipment.
6. Let instructor know if the bathroom toilet becomes plugged.



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Volunteer

1. Parents and Students will be required to volunteer a minimum of 5 hours during the six week session.
 - a) Helping in class (Parents only)
 - b) Moving donated aircraft or our own aircraft from place to place
 - c) Events that our schedule both student and parents should make an attempt to help out
 - d) E-Bay sales – helping with cleaning parts, identifying parts and list on E-bay or Facebook market place
 - e) Students or parents willing to help with projects outside of Build A Plane time.

All students must have a signed safety contract on file to participate in lab activities.
