We're thrilled to announce that **Flight Expo will be attending EAA AirVenture Oshkosh this July** and we're bringing our newly donated **53-foot educational trailer** with us!

This trailer will be part of **KidVenture**, a hands-on learning area for kids and teens located at **Pioneer Airport**, just north of the EAA Aviation Museum. With fun activities like flight simulators, model airplane building, safety wiring practice, and aviation history, **KidVenture helps young people explore the world of aviation in a fun and exciting way.**

Flight Expo will be hosting displays and interactive experiences inside our trailer all week long. We're proud to showcase **historic aircraft (including Tsunami!)**, tools, and hands-on stations that inspire the next generation of aviation professionals.

KidVenture is open:

- Monday–Saturday: 9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- Sunday: 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. (Shuttles run regularly from the main Bus Park to KidVenture.)

Young participants who complete a set of activities will receive a **Future Pilot** or **Future A&P (Airframe and Powerplant)** pin—and the first 1,500 to finish the skills challenges will also get a **free toolkit**, courtesy of Wing Aviation.

- **Unity3D WebGL online labs** (no special hardware required)

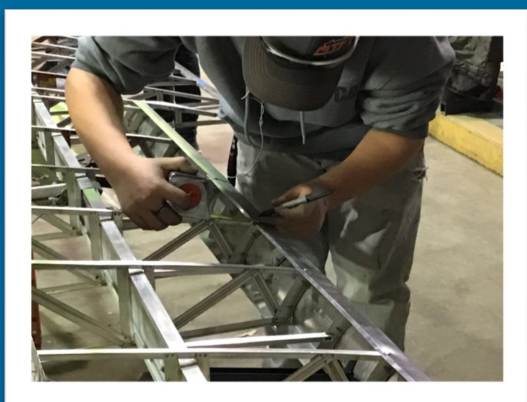
Students experience over **400 virtual simulations**, including real-world aviation tasks like:
