Believing each individual is created in the image of God, they see in each one the potential to live a meaningful life; something much better than mere survival on the street—getting a meal here, a coat and a blanket there, sleeping in a doorway, constantly in danger from the elements and those who wish to do them harm. UGM is all about change.
- **CVSD Food for Thought:** This program helps the SVP Food Bank supply weekend meals (2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 2 dinners, milk & various snacks) that fill a gap for students involved in the CVSD's Homeless Education & Resource Team program.
- **Lutherhaven Ministries:** Camp Lutherhaven on Lake Coeur d'Alene, Shoshone Mountain Retreat up the river, Shoshone Creek Ranch, Idaho Servant Adventures and Lutherhaven Day Camps serve groups, families, kids and adults all year round.
