
FROM THE PASTOR Jaynan Clark Hyphenated and Divided

few months ago as I grew more and more tired of all the tireless, false claims of America being wrought with systemic racism and white supremacy, I posted the following publicly:

"Things you can't say: there aren't African, Native, Asian, Hispanic Americans. We are Americans together equally. Stop dividing us to empower your selves."

One of my friends who is big into history responded: "Channeling your inner Teddy Roosevelt?" A bit confused by the comment, I responded, "Hmm... guess I've been compared to much worse." His response, "If you don't know, search Roosevelt's hyphenated speech." I did and this surprising history lesson appeared:

Theodore Roosevelt's opening line was hardly remarkable for a presidential campaign speech: "Friends, I shall ask you to be as quiet as possible." His second line; however, was a bombshell. "I don't know whether you fully understand that I have just been shot..." The horrified audience in the Milwaukee



Auditorium on October 14, 1912, gasped as the former president unbuttoned his vest to reveal his bloodstained shirt. "It takes more than that to kill a bull moose," the wounded candidate assured them. He reached into his coat pocket and pulled out a bullet-riddled, 50-page speech. Holding up his prepared remarks,

which had two big holes blown through each page, Roosevelt continued. "Fortunately I had my manuscript, so you see I was going to make a long speech, and there is a bullet — here is where the bullet went through — and it probably saved me from it going into my heart. The bullet is in me now, so that I cannot make a very long speech, but I will try my best..."

X-rays taken after the campaign event showed the bullet lodged against Roosevelt's fourth right rib on an upward path to his heart. Fortunately, the projectile had been slowed by his dense overcoat, steel-reinforced eyeglass case and hefty speech squeezed into his inner right jacket pocket.— Christopher Klein, "When Teddy Roosevelt Was Shot in 1912, a Speech May Have Saved His Life," History.com, July 21, 2019.

I admit that while I am a lover and student of history, I didn't even realize this had happened! I mean, "Wow!", he really was a bull moose of sorts. Obviously the good Lord kept Teddy alive for a reason. Roosevelt is known for many things but I was impressed with this new history I learned; yet, I still wondered what that had to do with my Facebook post? Then I scrolled down and saw the next link:

Teddy Roosevelt on hyphenated America: "No Room in This Country for Hyphenated Americans." A speech made October 12, 1915, to the Knights of Columbus in New York City. (Note: It was 3 years after he was shot and survived.)

"There is no room in this country for hyphenated Americanism. When I refer to hyphenated Americans, I do not refer to naturalized Americans. Some of the very best Americans I have ever known were naturalized Americans. Americans born abroad. But a hyphenated American is not an American at all. 'This is just as true of the man who puts 'native' before the hyphen as of the man who puts German

or Irish or English or French before the hyphen. Americanism is a matter of the spirit and of the soul. Our allegiance must be purely to the United States. We must unsparingly condemn any man who holds any other allegiance. But if he is heartily and singly loyal to this Republic, then no matter where he was born he is just as good an American as anyone else. The one absolutely certain way of bringing this nation to ruin, of preventing all possibility of its

continuing to be a nation at all, would be to permit it to become a tangle of squabbling nationalities, an intricate knot of German-Americans, Irish-Americans, English-Americans, French-Americans, Scandinavian-Americans or Italian-Americans, each preserving its separate nationality, each at heart feeling more sympathy with Europeans of that nationality than with the other citizens of the American Republic. The men who do not become Americans and nothing else are hyphenated Americans; and there ought to be no room for them in this country. The man

who calls himself an American citizen and who yet shows by his actions that he is primarily the citizen of a foreign land, plays a thoroughly mischievous part in the life of our body politic. He has no place here; and the sooner he returns to the land to which he feels his real heart allegiance, the better it will be for every good American."

Strong words indeed! I recall them here as a reminder of what strong, unifying leadership looks and sounds like. Do not confuse kingdom's here. Roosevelt is not diminishing in any way faith connection and allegiance to God. He is not elevating patriotism over faith. He is specifically addressing matters of the state in regards to the threat of tribalism, an ever present condition infecting the

human race. The encouragement of tribalism is now being relabeled and packaged as "identity politics". Its goal is to divide individuals into groups and identities, based on race, ethnicity, gender, and sexual preference. It is in direct opposition to the foundational principle of this nation: we are all created by God, equal in His sight, and our freedoms, our inalienable rights, are gifted to us by Him, not the Republic. The Republic is strengthened when we

> see, acknowledge, and celebrate our differences and yet pledge allegiance to "one nation, under God, indivisible with liberty and justice for all."

> It occurs to me that if Teddy Roosevelt had been alive during my lifetime he would certainly have objected to the hyphenated phrase, "African-American" also. Has anyone noticed how over the last few decades we've gone from Coloreds to Blacks to Black-Americans to African-Americans exclusively for many years? It was a "No-No" to say Blacks, and

now you rarely hear African-Americans. Now everything is about "Colored People" who are everyone except the Whites who are non-colored and viewed, by those who continue to play with the language and labels, to be the problem. Many are confused by this, but we shouldn't be. Bullies rarely use their fists, for usually they are weak and fearful, so they pick and cause problems with their words. They continue to push around and manipulate anyone who allows them to do so and especially those who support their intimidation and manipulation. Don't be fooled by their foolish tactics. Their goal is to divide, cause chaos and conquer. It is part of our human fallen nature and it should not be propagated but rather pointed out and defeated.





In this time of great cultural and political upheaval, it is necessary for each of us to be informed of who are the true dividers, liars and false prophets. They are not difficult to identify for they betray their true "heartfelt allegiance" in their words and deeds. One cannot claim to be for "equality" and pursue "equity", a basic tenet of Marxism that negates equality of opportunity and enforces equity of outcome. This is achieved through division, chaos, destruction of the church, the nuclear family, and ownership of private property, all in order to achieve complete dependence on the State-the ideological powers that be. According to their ideology, any means necessary are acceptable for the end result justifies their methodology. If you don't understand this historically, I suggest you become better informed on the pillars of Marxism and the practice of Machiavellianism.

Also remembering these historic words spoken by Alexander Hamilton in 1775, "The sacred rights of mankind are not to be rummaged for, among old parchments, or musty records. They are written, as with a sun beam in the whole volume of human nature, by the hand of the divinity itself; and can never be erased or obscured by mortal power."

Forgive us Father, for we know not what we do and don't do. Give us ears to hear the Truth of Your Word and Your Spirit, which is not one of timidity, to act faithfully. And please, God, bless our home land. Amen.

UGM Camp was established in 1992. It is held in Ford, WA for boys and girls ages 8-12 years old. It is held for eight different weeks over the summer from the end of June—August. UGM has invited churches to come partner with them so eight different churches take one whole week where they gather



impoverished children from their neighborhood and provide for them a free of charge week of camp. The church runs the program; teaching Bible lessons, leading worship, and crafts and games. They also provide counseling.



UGM does the infrastructure; providing the facility, the food, the lifeguards, and the nurses. UGM goes to the church in the neighborhood where the children live to gather them for their week of camp. When camp is over, the churches follow up on the children so they have a place to go to where they know they are loved and someone cares about them.






This women's ministry event is a warm, friendship-building night of eating together, watching a movie, and comfortable conversation about moral issues and biblical perspectives.
