

Horserace Shows Two-Man Race between Speedy and Shreve

Recent internal polling shows the crowded field in the 6th is a two-way race for the GOP nomination. Mike Speedy leads with 20%, ahead of Jefferson Shreve at 19%, with no other candidates demonstrating viability. With 42% of voters still undecided, Speedy's record as a conservative, pro-Trump leader places him in the strongest position to consolidate the conservative vote and win the majority of undecided voters. Unlike Shreve, whose positions starkly contrast with the pro-Trump base, Speedy represents the true conservative choice, capable of securing a victory in this competitive race.ⁱ



Mike Speedy: Strong Conservative with deep roots in the 6th District

In addition to his overall lead, Mike Speedy is defying conventional expectations with his strong presence in the Marion County portion of the 6th, leading 34% to 31% over Jefferson Shreve, despite Shreve's recent heavy spending (estimated 15 Million in 2023 Indianapolis Mayor's Campaign). This lead is a testament to Speedy's longstanding commitment to the district, where his consistent record as a staunch conservative, deep connections, and strong grassroots presence clearly resonates with voters.

Jefferson Shreve: A record of politics over principle

The hallmark of Jefferson Shreve's political career has been his commitment to political opportunism over principle, especially during his \$15 million failed mayoral campaign, where he eagerly abandoned conservatives on key issues like the right to life, rule of law, second amendment, and support for Donald Trump. Sherve's readiness to abandon core values for political expediency should be a preview of what 6th District Republicans should expect from him on tough fights in Washington.

Assessing the remaining field of candidates

Jamison Carrier, John Jacob, and Jeff Raatz, each polling at 5% or less, and the remaining candidates who are failing to garner even 1%, highlight an unknown field that will face significant challenges to compete with the top two candidates. Their ballot position is a result of obstacles ranging from low name recognition to a lack of roots in the district and highlights the difficulty they will have communicating an effective message and building a grassroots organization needed for a successful primary bid.

Speedy's Path to Victory – The Only Choice for Conservatives

Mike Speedy's path to victory in the 6th District is backed by unwavering conservative record and his outspoken endorsement of Donald Trump, standing in stark contrast to the vulnerabilities of Jefferson Shreve and the fragmented field of candidates trailing in the polls. Speedy's campaign, invigorated by an injection of over \$1 million in personal resources, clearly positions him as the rally point for conservatives in the district, across Indiana, and in Washington, D.C. His America First stance resonates deeply with voters seeking a strong representative in Washington. Speedy's America First platform dedicated financial resources, and the coalescing of conservative support give him strong momentum, uniting conservatives behind a candidate who is not only prepared to win but to represent the 6th District with conviction.

ⁱ Polling Methodology

Mark it Red conducted a poll of n = 900 likely 6th Congressional District Indiana Republican primary voters. Data was collected from February 20-22, 2024. The sample consisted of 51% live interviews (83% to cellphones and 17% to landline), and 49% to an online panel via SMS. The samples were selected from a state voter file and balanced by geography, age, gender and other proprietary demographics to confirm a representative GOP Primary sample. The survey has a margin of error of +/-3.3%.
