Clark County Quilters is proud to present their 47th Annual Regional Quilt and Fiber Arts Show, **QuiltFest Northwest**, October 20-21-22, 2022 at the Clark County Event Center, 17402 Delfel Rd., Ridgefield, WA.

Themed "Sunshine & Roses," the show will feature over 300 quilts created by the members of the Guild, along with special exhibits and events, challenge quilts, a vendor mall, the "Diana" Cherrywood traveling exhibit, the Fort Vancouver Tapestry, and much more.

This year's featured exhibit shows quilts made by members of the talented Felida Friends small quilt group.

Sunflowers for Ukraine is a sale of small quilts with proceeds to World Central Kitchen's relief efforts in Ukraine.

Each day a Quilt of Valor will be presented to honor a local veteran, and examples of Quilts of Valor will be on exhibit. Veterans and active duty military personnel are encouraged to attend, and will receive a military discount admission.

"Quilters have spent many hours designing, fabric shopping, sewing by machine and by hand to produce beautiful quilts. These quilts are made to be used and loved or displayed as beautiful works of art," said Marie Cook, QuiltFest NW co-chair.
