- 1. MSP: Gilsrud/Tabaka to adopt the agenda as presented.
- 2. ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE: Clerk Herheim presented 2022 proposed budget and potential expenditures and debt for City Council review.
  - MSP: Gilsrud/Tobiason to approve:
    - Keeping the Levy amount same as last year at \$286,000: \$251,000 General Fund; \$20,000 Library; \$15,000 Sewer (which includes):
      - \$5000 for street maintenance/fill for streets
      - Tools for maintenance \$1,500
      - Sewer cleaning \$4,500
      - Lift station annual \$750
      - Sewer Bugs \$3,000
      - Park/Ballfield approved for regular maintenance items
      - Cemetery tree removal \$2,000
      - Replace Kitchen Floor at City Hall \$1,000
      - Community clean-up day \$500
      - Truck Fund \$6,000
      - Street Patching \$10,000
  - M/S/P: Gilsrud/Tabaka to approve LLBS budget of \$27,000 as follows:
    - o \$5.000 set aside for unexpected major expenses
    - o 2 new coolers \$12,000
    - o 1 new freezer \$2.500
    - o Renovate LLBS sign area to prevent accidents \$2,000
    - o 2 new point of sale computers \$3,000
    - o Bonus for year-round full/part-time LLBS employees (based on 2.5% of profits up to \$2,500)
  - M/S/P: Tabaka/Gilsrud to approve Docksider budget of \$12,149 as follows:
    - o 15 new chairs approximately \$570
    - o 40 new bar stools \$3,700
    - o 40" sliding door cooler \$2,400
    - o 8-9ft patio umbrellas approximately \$480
    - o \$5,000 set aside for unexpected repairs
  - MSP: Tabaka/Tobiason to approve request for \$250 donation to Initiative Foundation.
  - M/S/P: Gilsrud/Tobiason to approve proceeding with obtaining necessary surveys required to pave Birch Lane and set aside \$40,000 in restricted savings for repaving in 2023. And, to approve \$32,500 for paving of Riverside Drive in 2022.
  - M/S/P: Gilsrud/Tobiason to approve \$65,000 for replacement of street lights
  - M/S/P: Gilsrud/Tabaka to allocate \$30,000 from unused 2020 Docksider Budget to plan for new public restrooms
  - M/S/P: Tobiason/Gilsrud to approve \$4,700 for staining of ballfield main building, split rail fence, and benches
