Clerk Herheim presented 2021 proposed budget and potential expenditures and debt for City Council review.

 - Road striping left over from 2020
 - Garage door and opener replacement for shop \$4,200
 - Update shops lights to LED \$1,935
 - Maintenance employee shirts \$300

 - Sewer Bugs \$3,000
 - Park/Ballfield approved for regular maintenance items
 - Cemetery tree removal \$1,500
 - Conference chairs for City Hall \$2,500

 - Computer monitor \$150
 - Girl Lake Milfoil \$250
