 - a. Rental of Pavilion
 - i. Park Board met on 4/19 and voted 4:3 to continue to charge a non-refundable deposit in the amount of \$100 for rental of the Pavilion.
 - ii. It was discussed to add a statement in the rental agreement that if the garbage is not removed by those renting the pavilion, there will be an additional charge of \$100 for refuse removal.
 - iii. Suggestion was made to purchase a cork board, to be enclosed behind a glass case, where the pavilion rental schedule, rules, or other information to be shared such as pickle ball schedule, various tournaments, etc. can be posted.
 - b. Vandalism at the park
 - i. There has been no vandalism at the park in the past month
 - ii. Internet has been installed and activated for security cameras
 - c. Costs associated with maintenance, garbage removal, etc.
 - i. Suggestion was made for the Park Board to request donations from the Townships.
 - ii. Only approximately \$1,800 was gained over the past 3 years from the endowment from Scott Stuart. It was recommended that we investigate whether or not it makes sense to roll the money from the Initiative Foundation each year, so that it will grow and then the park will be able to self-sustain through the interest.
