Criteria	Description	Score (1–5)
Biblical Accuracy	Proper use of Scripture; faithfulness to the text and sound doctrine.	
Organization & Structure	Clear introduction, body, and conclusion; logical flow.	
Delivery & Presence	Confidence, clarity, tone, pacing, and eye contact (if live).	
Spiritual Depth	Demonstrates understanding of Scripture and spiritual application.	
Audience Engagement	Ability to connect, inspire, and maintain interest.	
Time Management	Stayed within required time limits (3, 5, and 10 minutes).	
Overall Effectiveness	Impact of message and anointing demonstrated.
