Program Overview

Students are equipped to serve as Certified Christian Life Coaches, mentors, and ministry leaders—or to continue toward a Bachelor or Doctor of Divinity degree.

This program is ideal for students seeking **flexibility**, **affordability**, and **hands-on ministry training** through Lamad University's online, correspondence, and hybrid course options.

■ Core Curriculum (13 Courses × 3 Credits = 39 Credits)

#	Course Title	Description
1	Foundations of Faith and Christian Living	Explores salvation, discipleship, and spiritual growth through Scripture.
2	Old Testament Survey	Overview of God's covenantal history from Genesis to Malachi.
3	New Testament Survey	Examines the life of Christ and the birth of the Church.
4	Introduction to Biblical Interpretation	Teaches students how to interpret Scripture using biblical hermeneutics.
5	Christian Ethics and Moral Decision Making	Applies biblical values to modern moral and coaching challenges.
6	Introduction to Christian Leadership	Examines the servant-leadership model and ministry teamwork.
7	The Power of Prayer and Worship	Cultivating intimacy with God through spiritual disciplines.
8	Biblical Communication and Public Speaking	Practical training in preaching, teaching, and effective delivery.
9	Evangelism and Discipleship	Methods of reaching the lost and nurturing new believers.
10	Introduction to Counseling and Coaching Principles	Basics of faith-based life coaching and relational guidance.
11	Biblical Human Development: From Childhood to Maturity	Examines human growth stages and spiritual development.
12	Ministry Administration and Ethical Leadership	Fundamentals of ministry operations, time management, and ethics.
13	Humanities in the Bible (Humanities Core)	Studies the influence of biblical literature, art, and music.

** Life Coach Certification Program (13 Modules = 30 Credits)

Students earn their **Certified Christian Life Coach Credential** through Lamad University's School of Coaching.

CLEP-Out Option for Core Courses

Students may CLEP out of any or all core courses by passing the Lamad University Credit-by-Examination (CLEP-Out) assessment.

- Each CLEP exam costs \$65 per course.
- Students receive a **study guide** for preparation.
- Exams are **not timed**, allowing thoughtful completion.
- A minimum score of 80% is required to pass and receive full course credit.
- Successfully CLEPing out of all 13 courses reduces total tuition by \$2,535 and allows completion of the associate degree in as little as 6–9 months.
