

m Lamad University Ministerial Licensing via Minister Track (A.Div Path)

At Lamad University, we believe a believer's call to ministry should be acknowledged, equipped, and credentialed — not burdened by excessive expense or bureaucracy. Through our **Minister Track** embedded in the **Associate of Divinity (A.Div)** program, undergraduate students who meet academic, character, and ministry benchmarks will be eligible to receive a **Ministerial License** through Lamad University.

Qualifying Requirements

To receive ministerial licensing through the Lamad Minister Track, a student must:

- Be enrolled in the A.Div program and successfully complete Lamad's Minister Track courses, which include theological foundations, ministry leadership, biblical studies, and spiritual formation.
- 2. Maintain a GPA of 75% (C average) or higher in all Minister Track and core courses.
- 3. Pass a **license evaluation interview** with a Lamad Ministerial Board, demonstrating doctrinal alignment, calling, character, and ministry vision.
- 4. Complete a **practicum or supervised field service assignment** appropriate to their area of ministry (e.g. preaching, teaching, outreach) under mentor supervision.
- 5. Submit references, a ministry statement, and a signed commitment to abide by Lamad's Ministerial Code of Conduct.

Licensing Benefits & Authority

- Credential Recognition: Graduates carrying this license may present it to churches, ministries, or associations as proof of biblical and theological training from Lamad University.
- **Pastoral Appointment:** Eligible for candidacy for pastoral or ministry roles within participating churches or ministries that recognize Lamad's license.
- Continuing Education: Licensed ministers are expected to maintain annual reporting of ministry service, ethical standing, and ongoing training to remain in good standing with Lamad.

Transfer & Pathway for Graduates

- Students who already possess a degree (B.Div, M.Div, etc.) may still apply to enter Lamad's Ministerial Licensing process by completing any outstanding Minister Track requirements and passing the licensing interview.
- Ministerial License holders may convert or upgrade their license to higher licensure status during further graduate studies (e.g. D.Div track) with Lamad's approval.

Lamad University Ministerial Tuition & Oversight Program

Purpose

The Ministerial Training and Oversight Program equips emerging and licensed ministers with the spiritual, academic, and practical foundations needed for effective service in ministry. Participants will gain both *biblical knowledge* and *hands-on ministry experience* while being mentored under apostolic leadership.

I. Tuition Structure

Program Component	Description	Tuition / Fee	Duration
Ministerial Training Program	Academic and practical ministry preparation for ministers, elders, and those preparing for licensing or ordination. Includes coursework in theology, pastoral care, preaching, leadership, and ethics.	\$400	Self-paced or 6-month module
Watchful Oversight Program	For ministers who do not currently have a covering or church home. Participants are connected to an Apostolic Association and receive one-on-one mentorship under an Apostle. Includes monthly coaching, field service review, and accountability.	\$1,000 (12 months) or \$50/month	12 months

Tuition may be paid in full or through a monthly payment plan. Payment must be completed prior to final evaluation or credentialing.

II. Program Overview

A. Ministerial Training (\$400)

Learning Focus Areas

- Biblical Foundations Hermeneutics, Old & New Testament Survey, Theology of Ministry
- 2. **Spiritual Development** Prayer, fasting, consecration, and spiritual disciplines

- 3. **Pastoral Competency** Preaching, weddings, funerals, communion, baptism, and pastoral counseling
- 4. **Leadership & Administration** Church structure, governance, and servant leadership
- 5. Ethics & Character Formation Integrity, accountability, and moral leadership

Completion Requirements

- Attend or complete all assigned courses/modules
- Submit a brief Ministry Portfolio (sermon outlines, reflection journal, community service log)
- Receive recommendation from program faculty or mentor

B. Watchful Oversight Program (\$1,000 / 12 Months)

This program is for ministers launching a new ministry, starting an online or outreach church, or operating independently who desire apostolic accountability.

Includes:

- Enrollment under the Apostolic Mantle of Covering
- Monthly mentorship sessions with your assigned Apostle
- Field service assignments and evaluation of ministry activities
- **Demonstration / Observation Checklist** covering key ministerial duties:
 - Weddings & Funerals
 - Communion & Baptism
 - Pastoral Coaching & Counseling
 - Outreach & Community Service

Church Administration & Ethics

Oversight Expectations

- Meet with your Apostle or Supervisor monthly
- Submit quarterly ministry reports
- Participate in at least one Lamad University or Association event per year
- Remain in good moral and financial standing during the 12-month period

III. Credentialing & Recognition

Upon successful completion of both the Ministerial Training and Watchful Oversight components, participants may be eligible for:

- Certificate of Ministerial Completion (from Lamad University)
- Ministerial License or Ordination (upon approval and recommendation)
- Affiliation with the Apostolic Association Network
- Listing in the Lamad Ministerial Registry

IV. Additional Information

- **Renewal:** Ministers under oversight must renew their covering annually if continuing beyond the initial 12 months.
- **Transfers:** Those already licensed by another organization may submit documentation for evaluation and placement within the Lamad network.
- **Scholarships:** Partial scholarships or payment plans may be available upon request.
