# The Spectrum of Human Abilities

#### **Disability:**

 A disability is a condition of the body or the mind that creates difficulty for a person to interact with their environment.

#### Disabilities can affect a persons:

- Vision
- Movement
- Thinking
- Memory
- Learning
- Communicating
- Mental Health
- Social Relationships

#### WHO Dimensions of Disability:

- Impairment Limitation in their body or mental function. For example; limb, eyesight, or memory loss.
- Activity Limitation Difficulty hearing, seeing, or problem solving.
- Participation Restrictions Limitations with engaging in social activities, normal daily tasks, and obtaining health services.

# Cognitive Disability

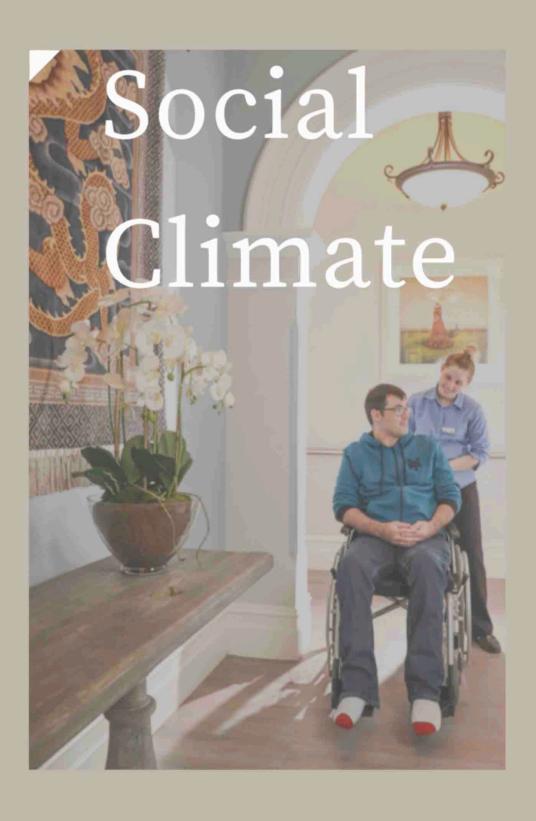
Cognitive disabilities can manifest in a variety of ways. People who have a cognitive disability may experience memory deficits, attention deficits, problem-solving deficits, visual comprehension deficits, and reading, linguistic, and verbal comprehension deficits.

Examples of cognitive disabilities include

- Down Syndrome
- Learning disabilities
- Head injuries
- Stroke
- Alzheimer's Disease

# Disability Prevalence in the U.S

- 1 in 4 adults in the United States have some type of disablility, which translates to nearly 61 million people.
- About 10.7% of Americans have a function cognitive disability.
- The national prevalence of people with cognitive disabilities increases with age, starting at 4.2% for those 5-12 and doubles to 8.9% for those 65 and older.



- Modern society has trended towards normalizing and understanding individuals with disabilities.
- Advancements in medical treatments and therapies have given individuals with disabilities a better quality of life. Helping to change the perception of disabilities.
- Legislation like the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) have brought protection to individuals with disabilties in the built environment.
- Awareness and education through forms of digital media have increased acceptance and understanding from a broader portion of society.
- Societies terminology used to describe people with disabilities has changed drastically.
- Concepts like Universal Design and Accessible Design are being adopted to create more inclusive environments.

# How to Design for Disabilities

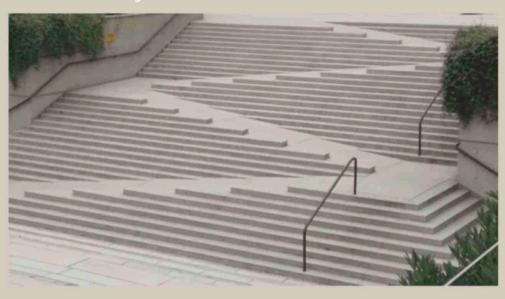
#### **Design Considerations:**

To check the effectiveness of a disabled design solution, answer the following questions: is the design still usable and safe if...?

- Are using it for the first time?
- Cannot read?
- Perform steps out of order?
- Try to use it much faster or slower than intended?
- Make a mistake or want to start over?
- Are distracted or interrupted while using it?

## Sunriver Resort & Spa Huangshan Huangshun, China

The Japanese word 'Aimai' guides K5 Tokyo's concept. It means vague, obscure or ambiguous, which in Japan is often used in a positive, poetic sense. K5 Tokyo's functions intentionally intermingle, enabling its spaces to adapt their character to the ebb and flow of activity. The library is the bar. The flower shop is the lounge, which is also the café, which is also the wine bar, which is also the restaurant.

The local lack of greenery inspired the creation of a 'green oasis' in K5 Tokyo. The flower shop forms an 'oasis', within the reception lounge, together with a multitude of potted plants spread out, aimai fashion, in the restaurant, corridors and guest rooms. K5 Tokyo has a gardener but no traditional garden.

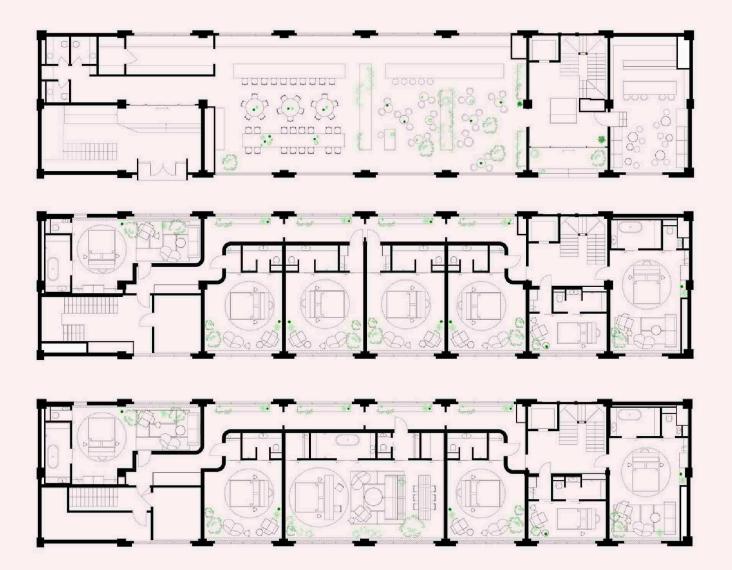
The palette consists of traditional materials such as concrete, cedar and Japanese stucco, all finely executed. Complemented by a wide range of furniture and accessories, custom designed by the architects.









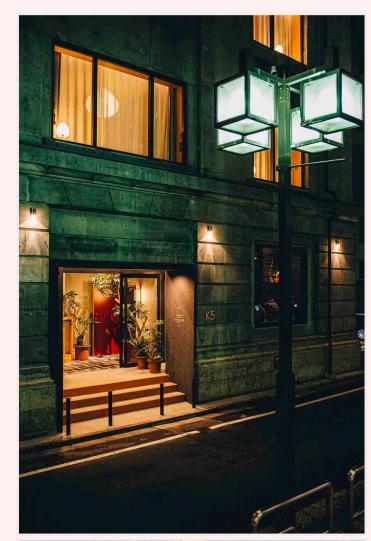


## K5 TOKYO Tokyo Japan

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Lugano Dante is an empathetic hotel, where guests, tourists, citizens can take part to a conference or an event, spend a day of work or relaxation, enjoy a meal or indulge in an aperitif in a new F&B offer within the lobby and dining room spaces, conceived as a single free-flow space.

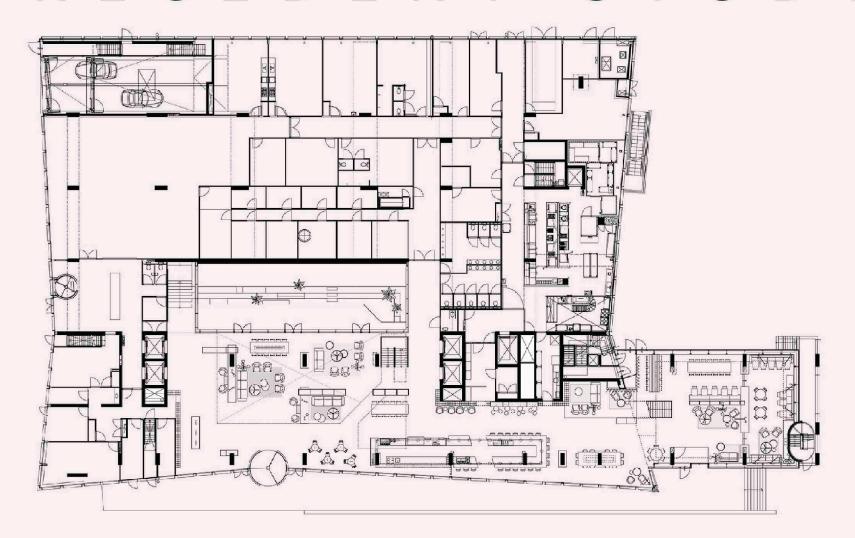
The hotel rooms are divided according to the type of intervention: 43 will be subject to a substantial revamping that excludes the renovation of the bathrooms, while 26 rooms are subject to a completely new overall design. The total of the 69 rooms has been divided, according to the needs expressed, into 6 types of offer and hospitality: single room, twin room, double room, superior double room, studio suite and a room on two levels renamed "loft".









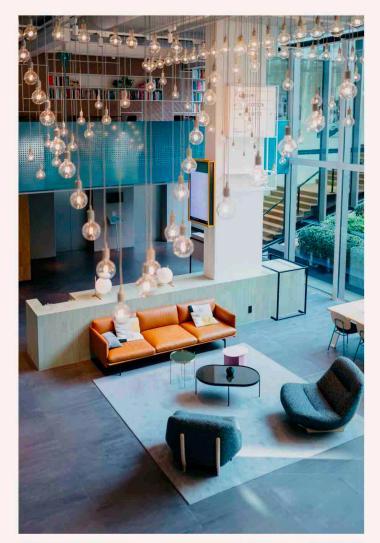


### Hotel Casa Amsterdam Amsterdam, Netherlands

Amsterdam's Hotel Casa was founded in 1950, and has always been a hybrid between a hotel and (temporary) housing for students. In 2010, Hotel Casa moved buildings and a complete renovation of the building completed in 2019. In this new design, connectivity was key. With one large public space for visitors to enjoy, the lobby focuses being one big "living room" that can serve as a place to relax, work, study or eat depending on the type of visitor, their mood or time of day.

The bar is a central element to the design, and acts as a bridge between the different areas and serves as the heart of the hotel. The side facing the check-in acts as a coffee bar while the side facing the restaurant serves as a traditional hotel bar with fine drinks and a seasonal dinner menu.

The lobby extends to the second floor. To increase the new connectivity between the lobby and the second floor, a staircase has been added that leads to the new mezzanine, which opens up the area easily to other visitors as well. By creating a wide mezzanine, the second and ground floor are physically linked, allowing for more interaction between guests and visitors by creating even more different "moods."







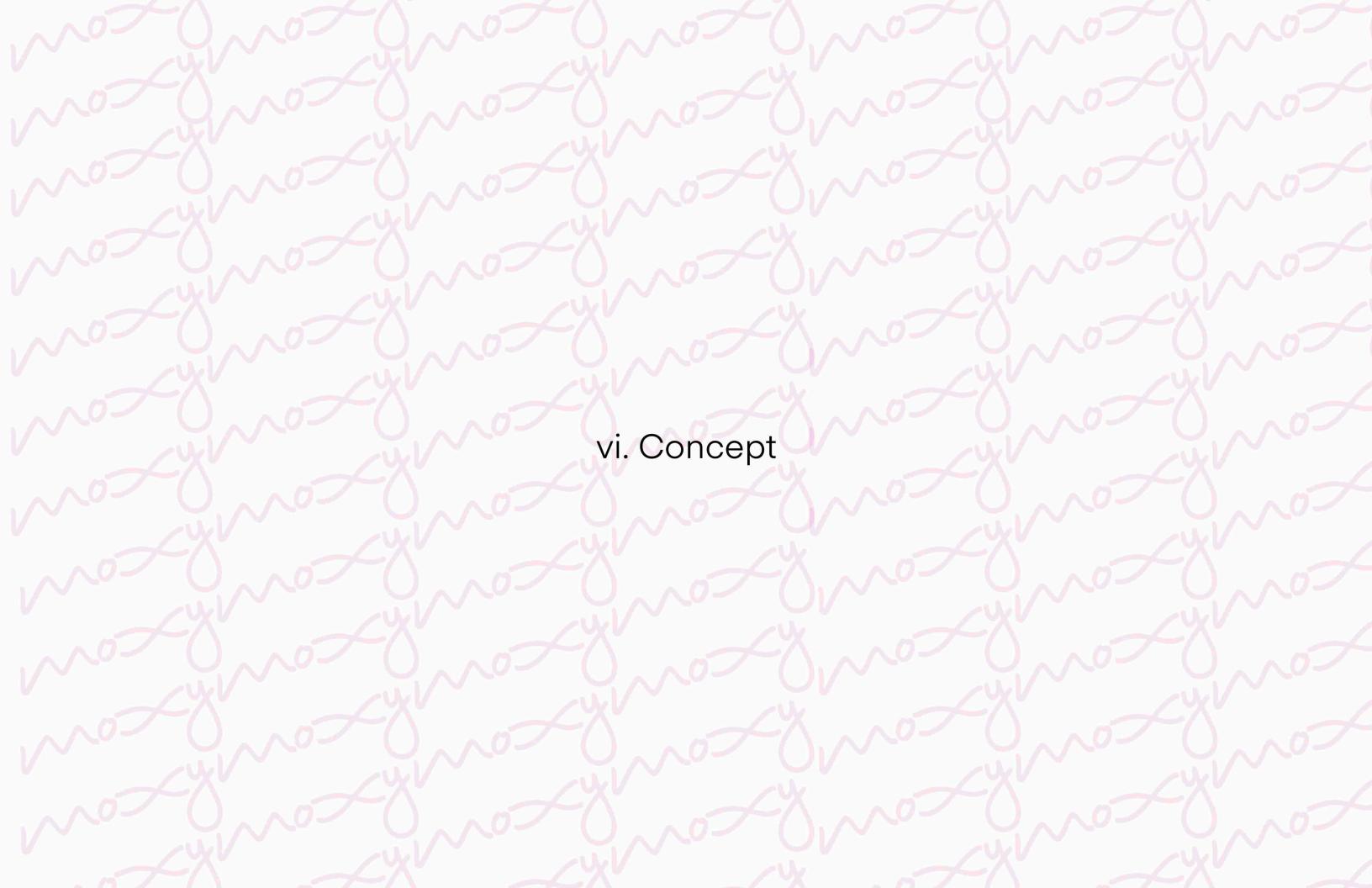


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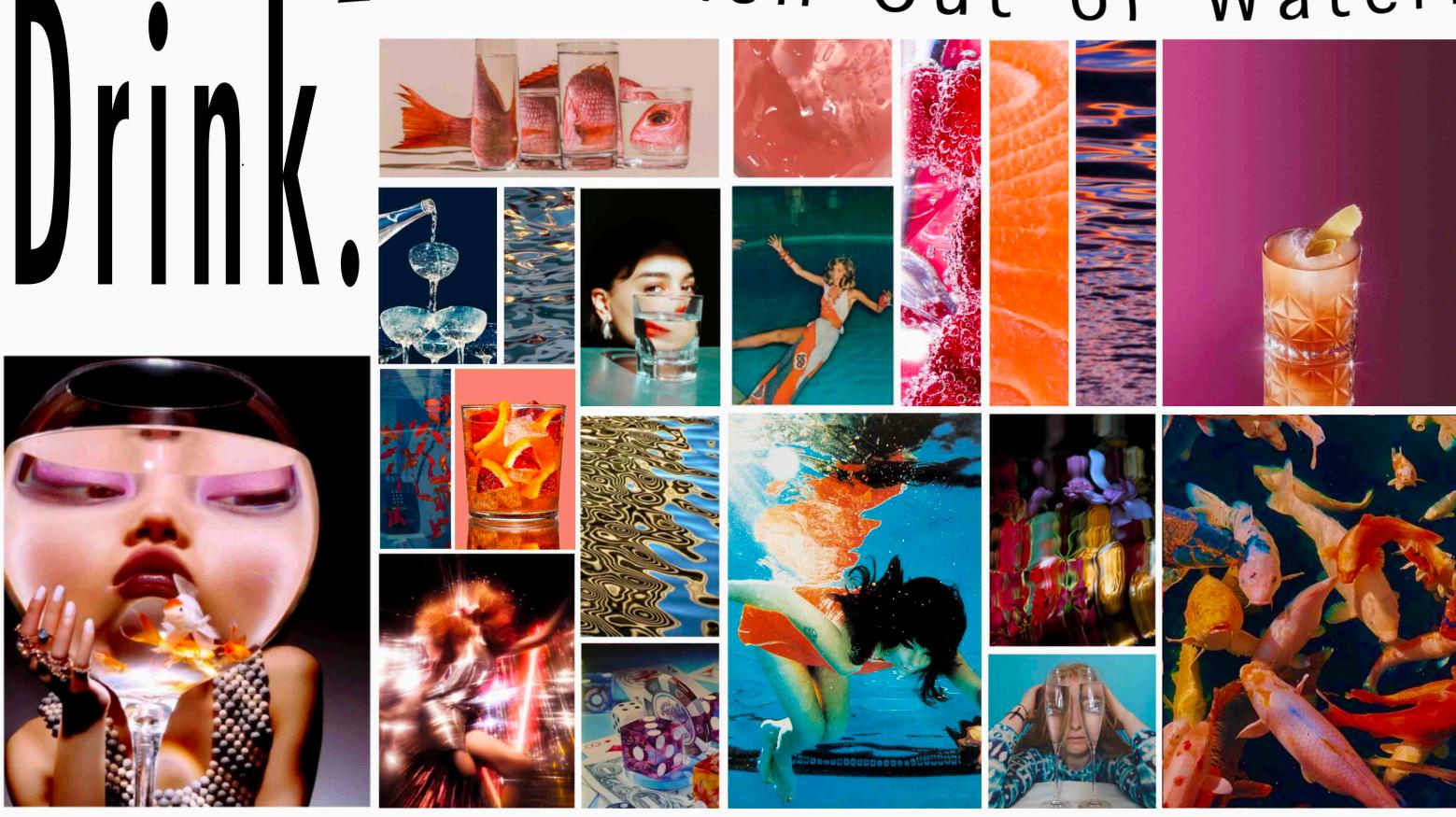




"Drink. Like a Fish Out of Water" acknowledges the subtle unease and restlessness that may come with being in an usual and unfamiliar environment and actively seeks to allievate that discomfort. By employing two of the Moxy brand's better known motifs — "Moxy is for play" & the signature complementary cocktail at check in — as a central column to the concept, this design hopes to provide a sense of ambiguity, which can be very comforting to a traveling clientele.

Users will experience an indefinite space. As with the check-in and bar already being one-and-the-same, the boundaries between the bar, lounge, game room, business center, and other points of interest will be blurred and hard to pinpoint, creating an area with limitless possibilities.

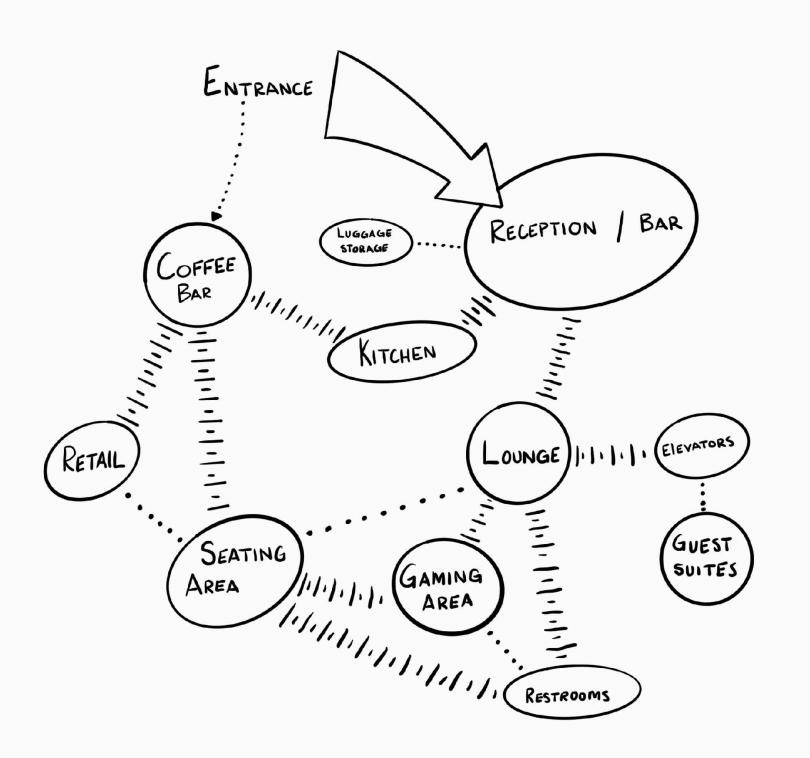


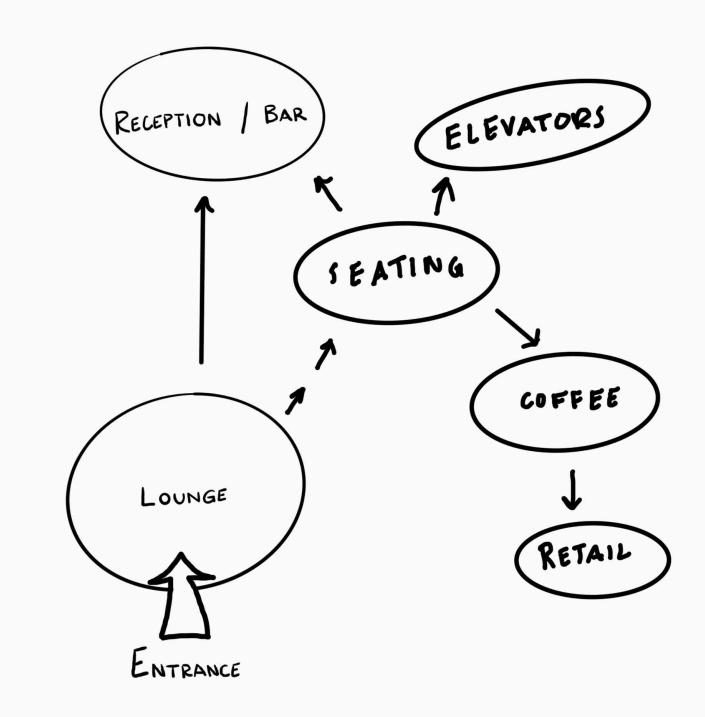


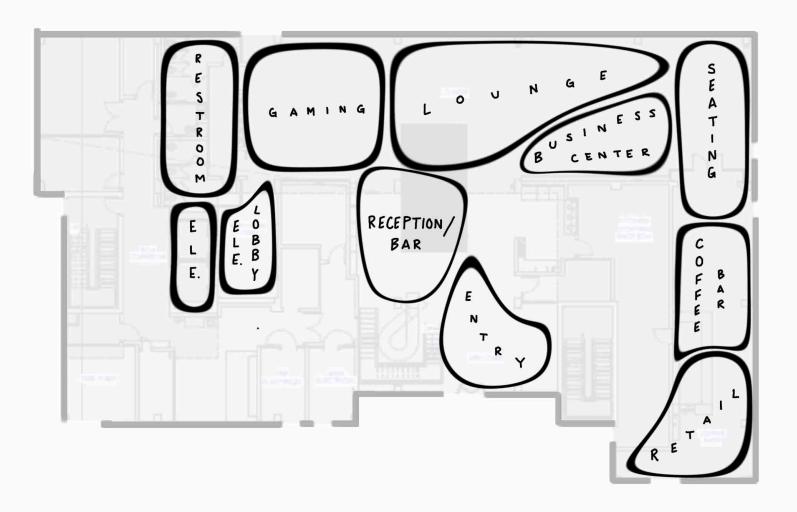


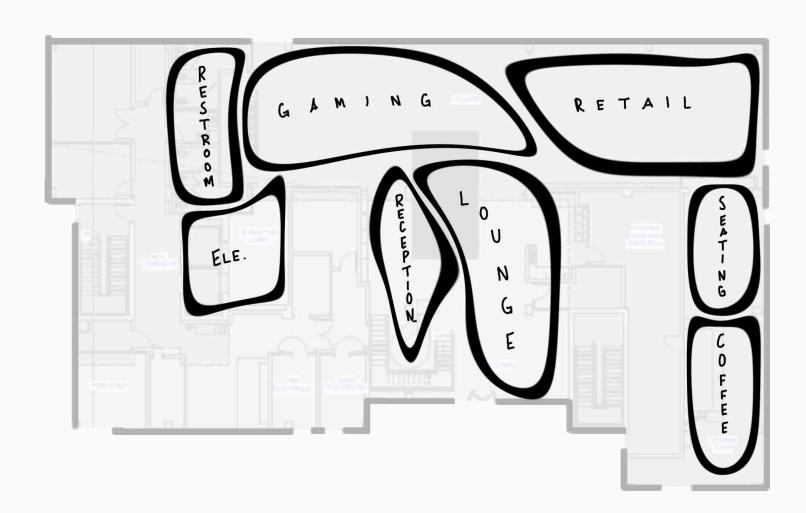


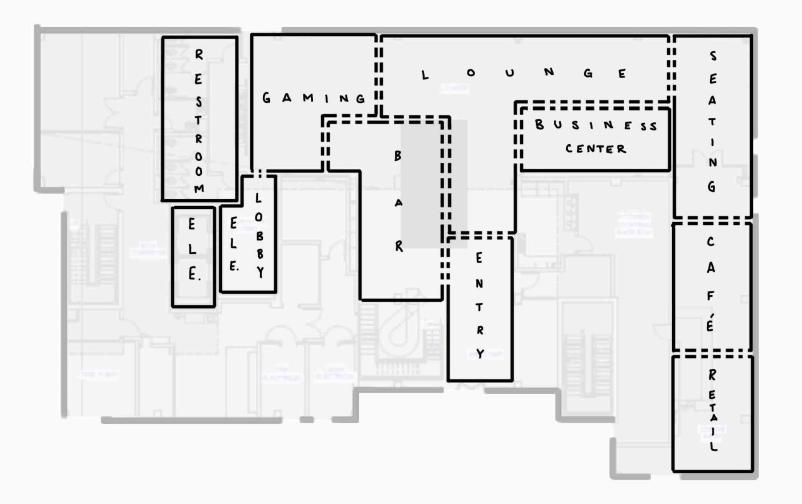


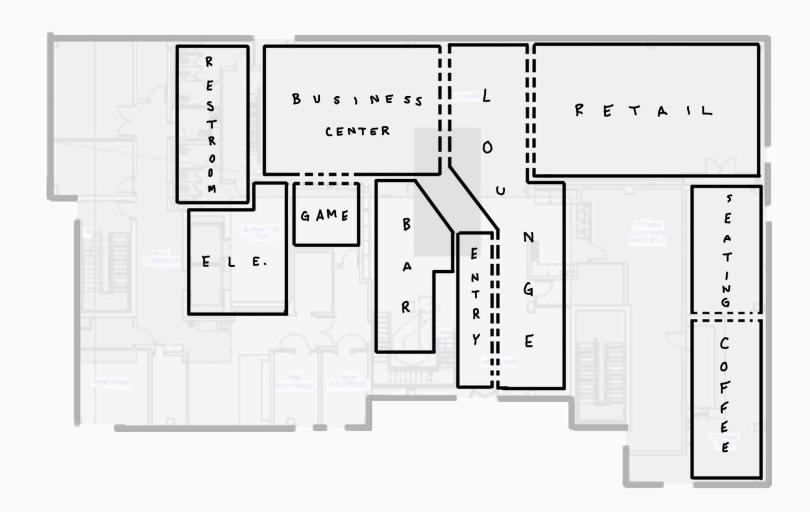


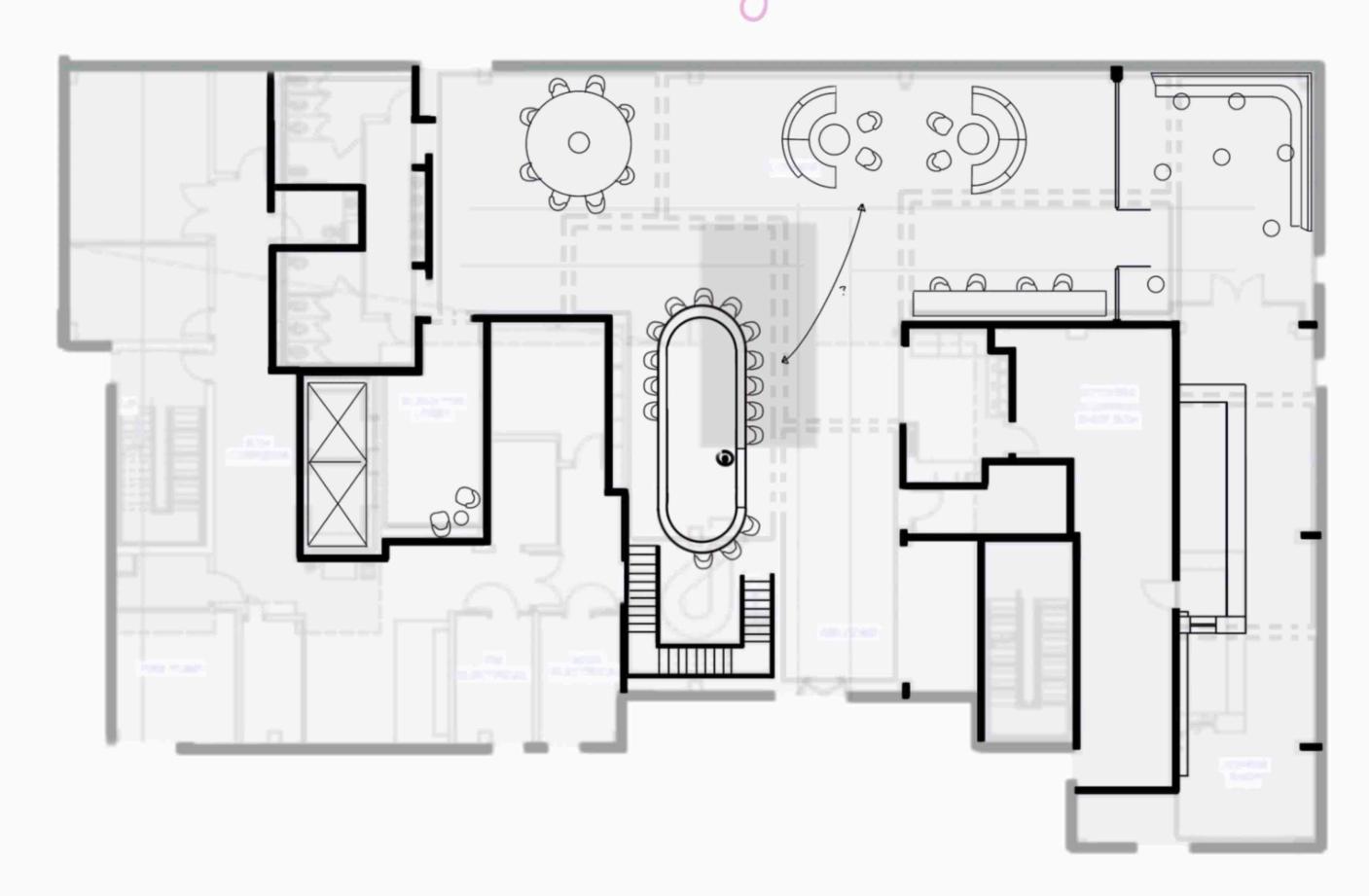




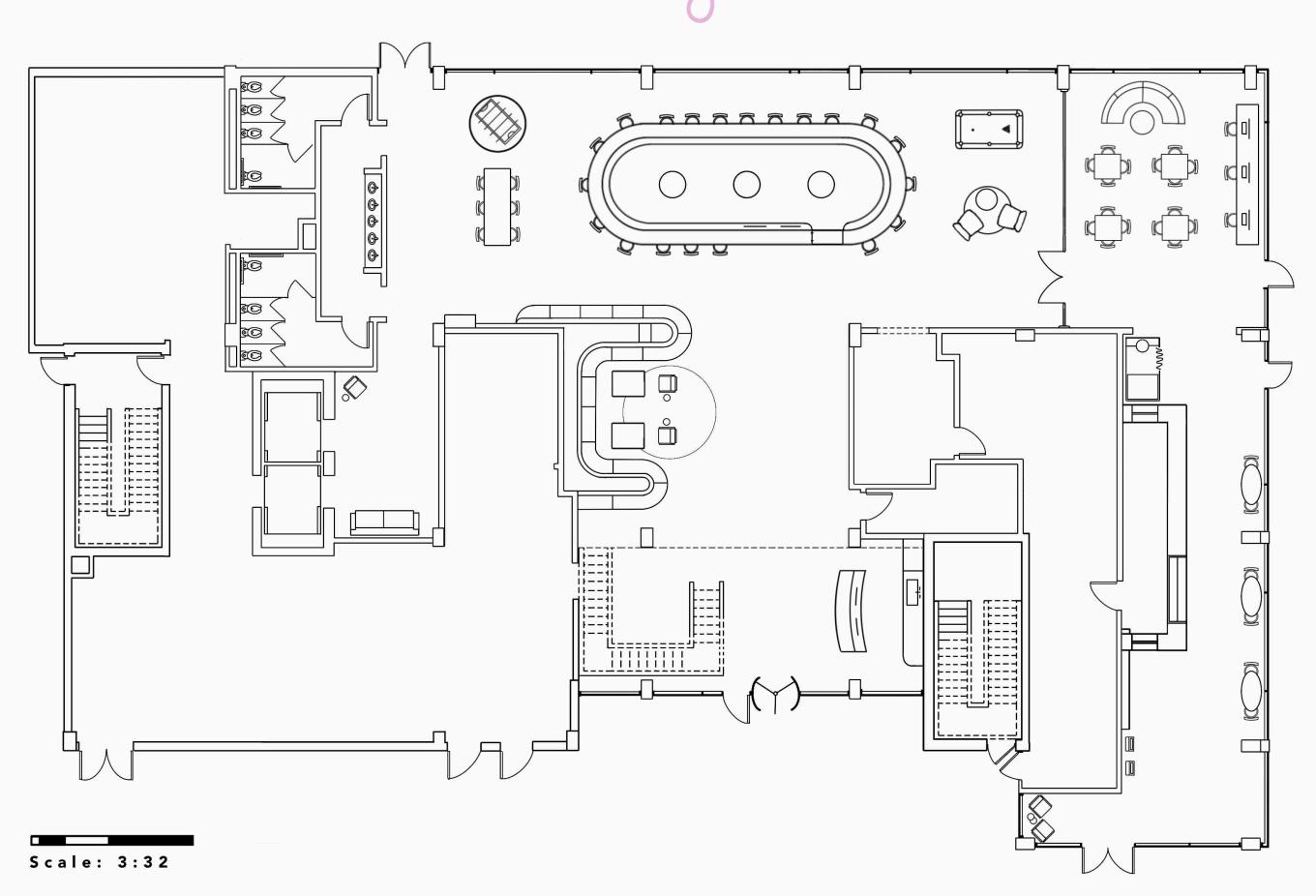




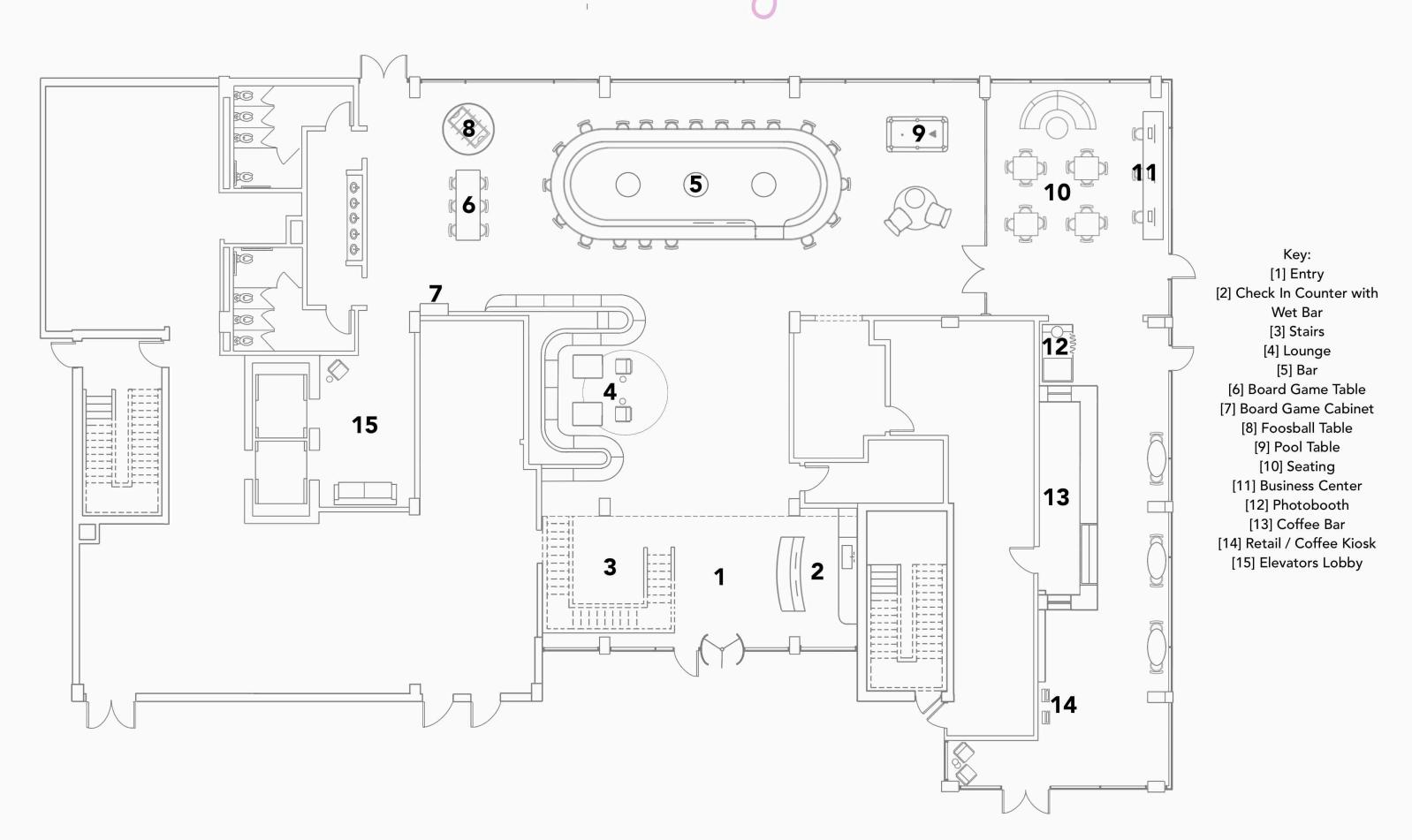




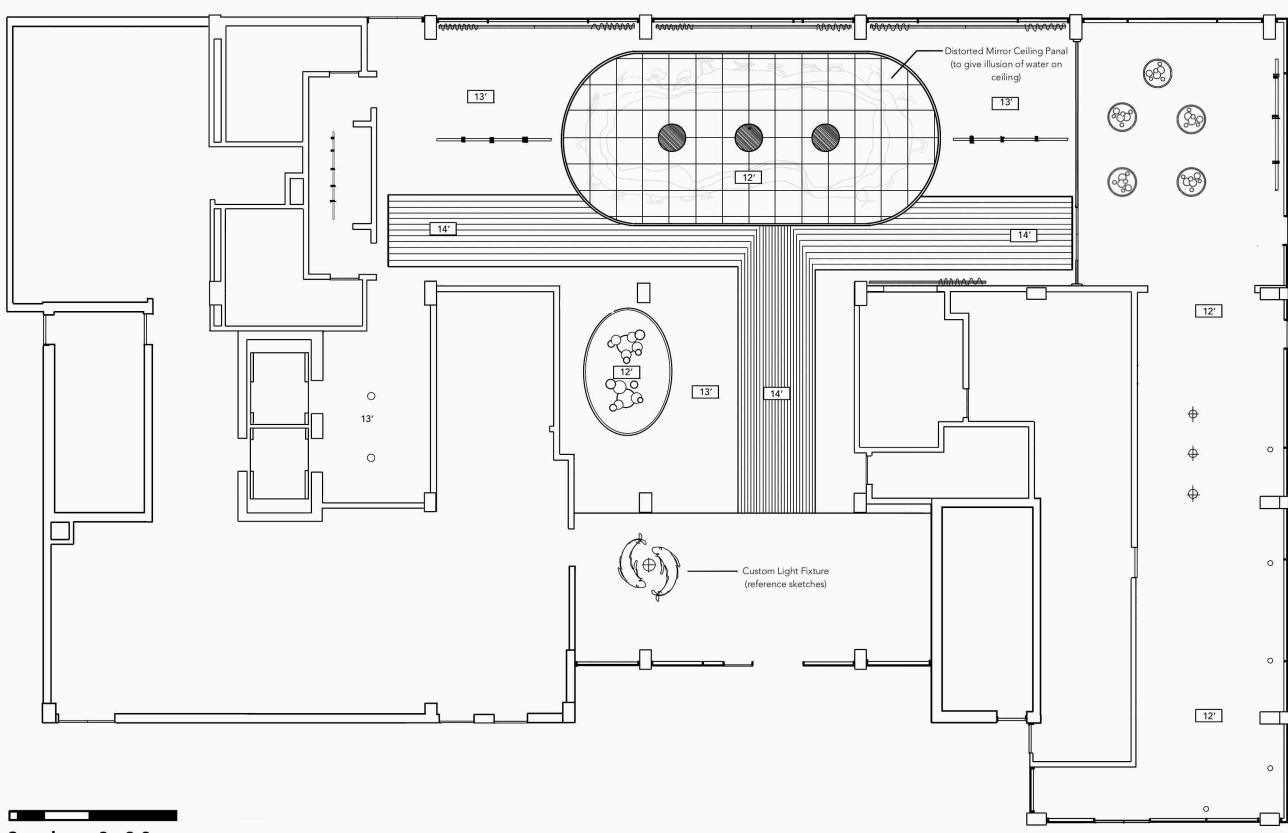




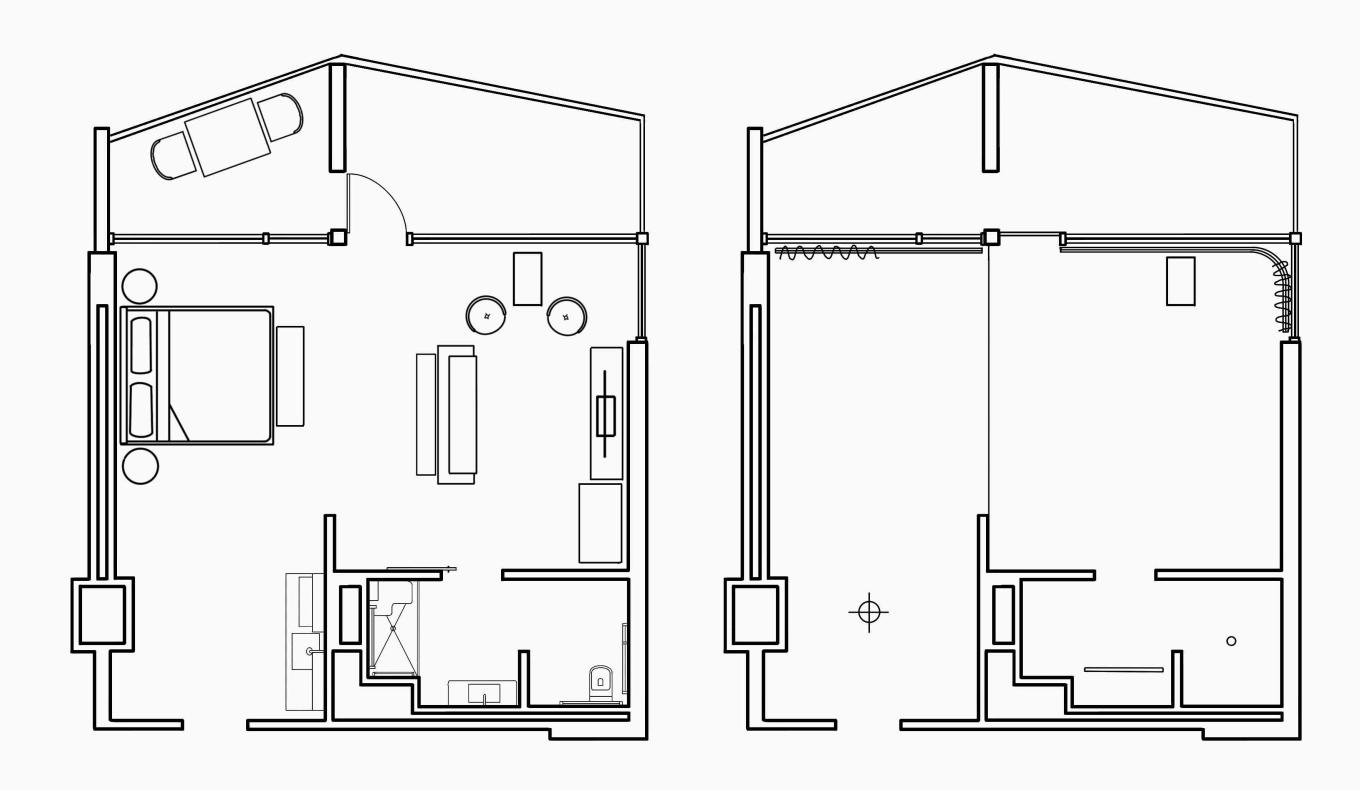
#### Annotated Preliminary Floor Plan 1201 Atlantic Avenue, Virginia Beach, VA, USA

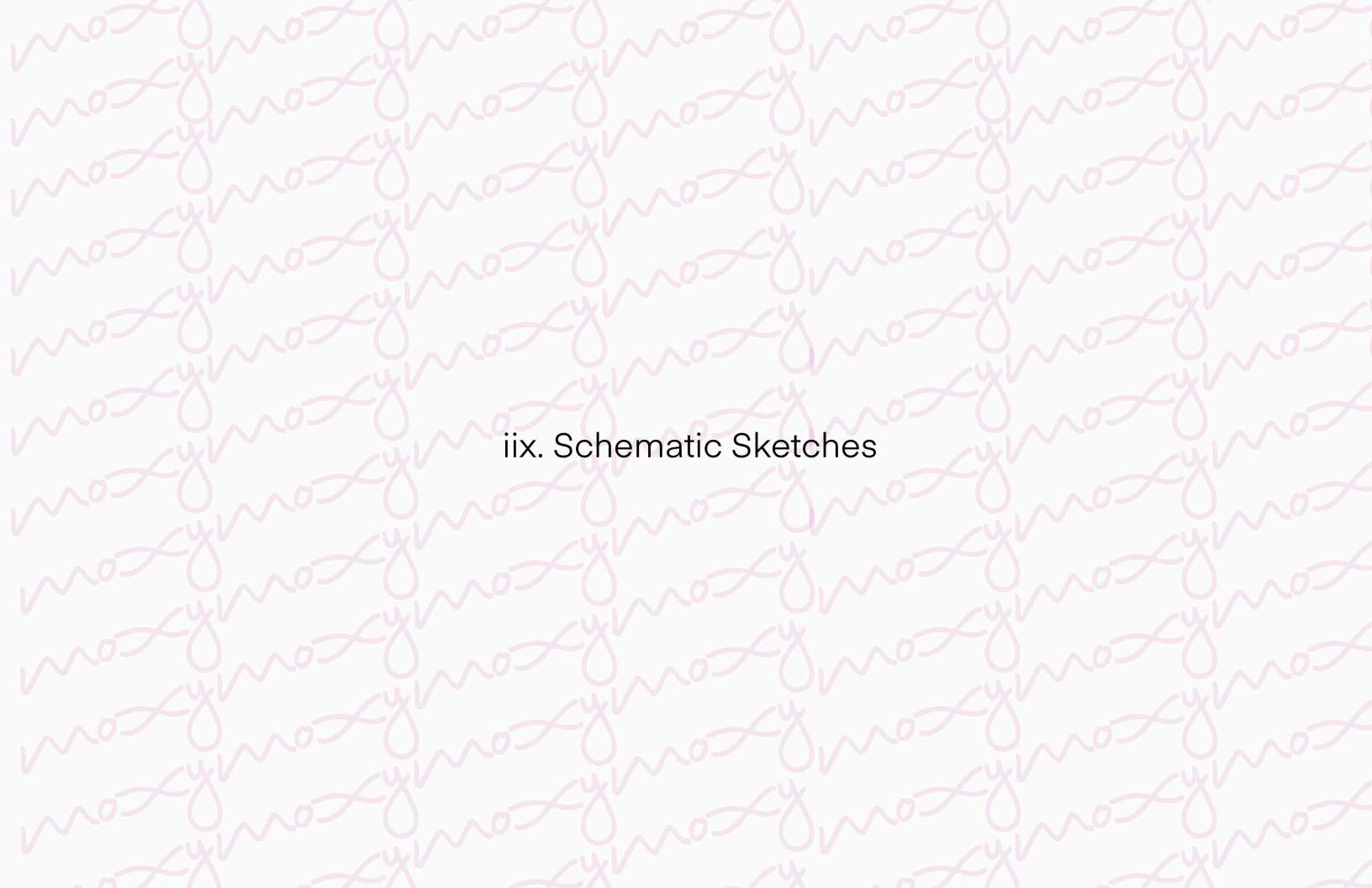


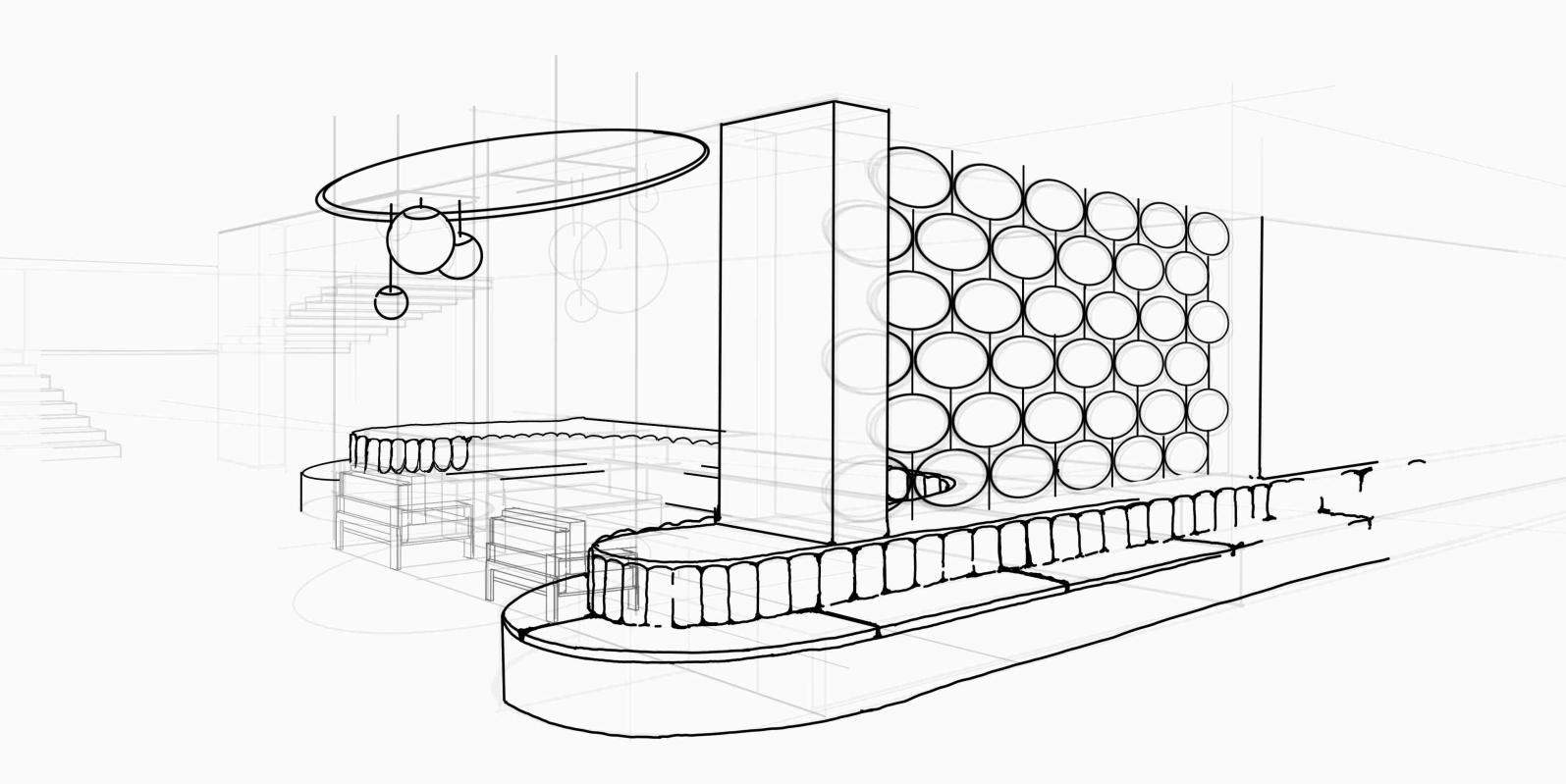
#### Preliminary Reflected Ceiling Plan 1201 Atlantic Avenue, Virginia Beach, VA, USA

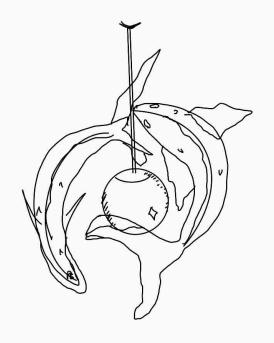


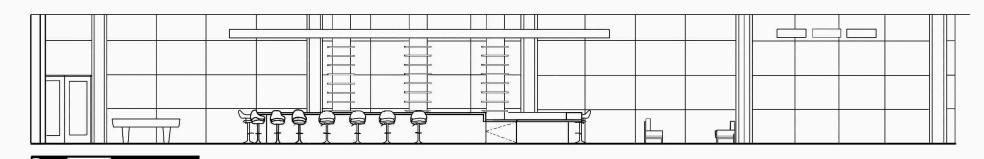
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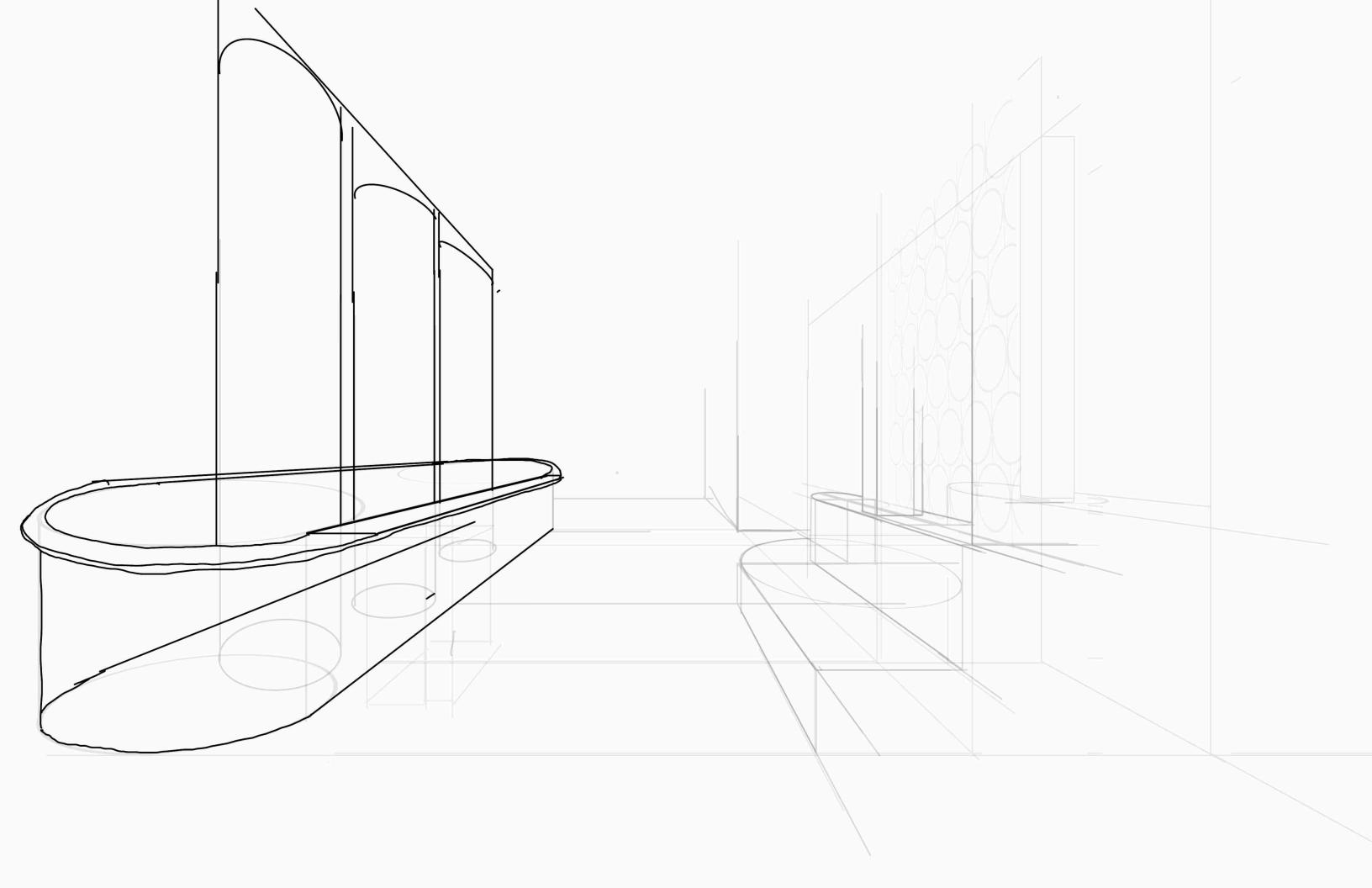


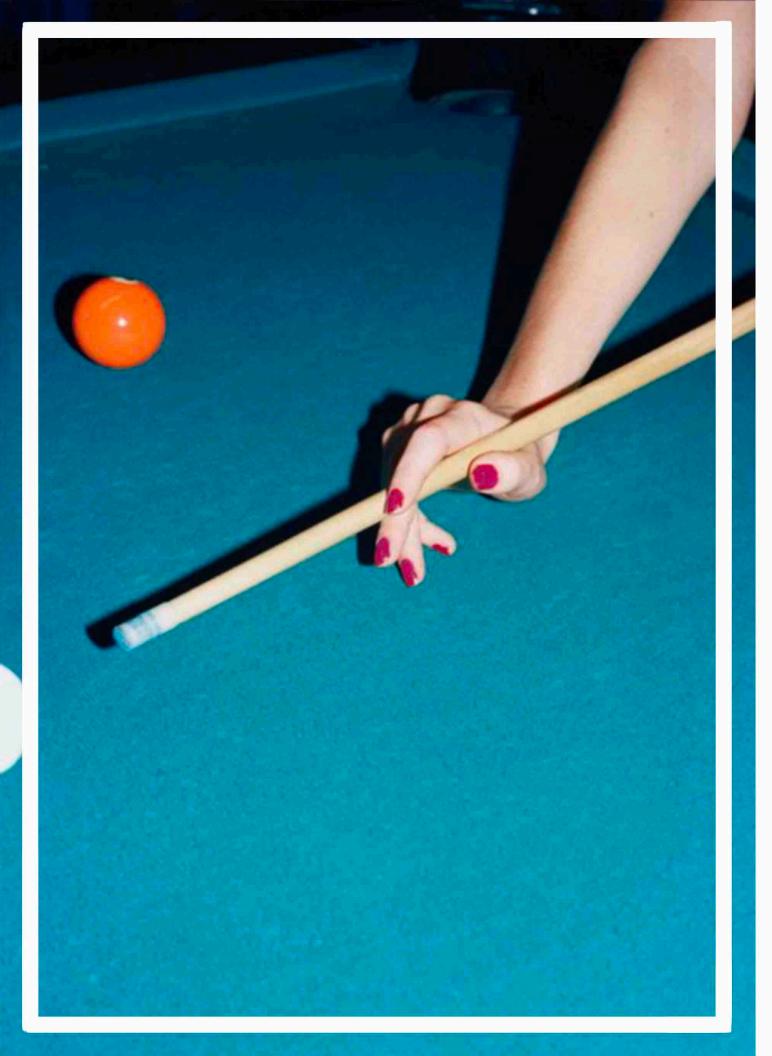






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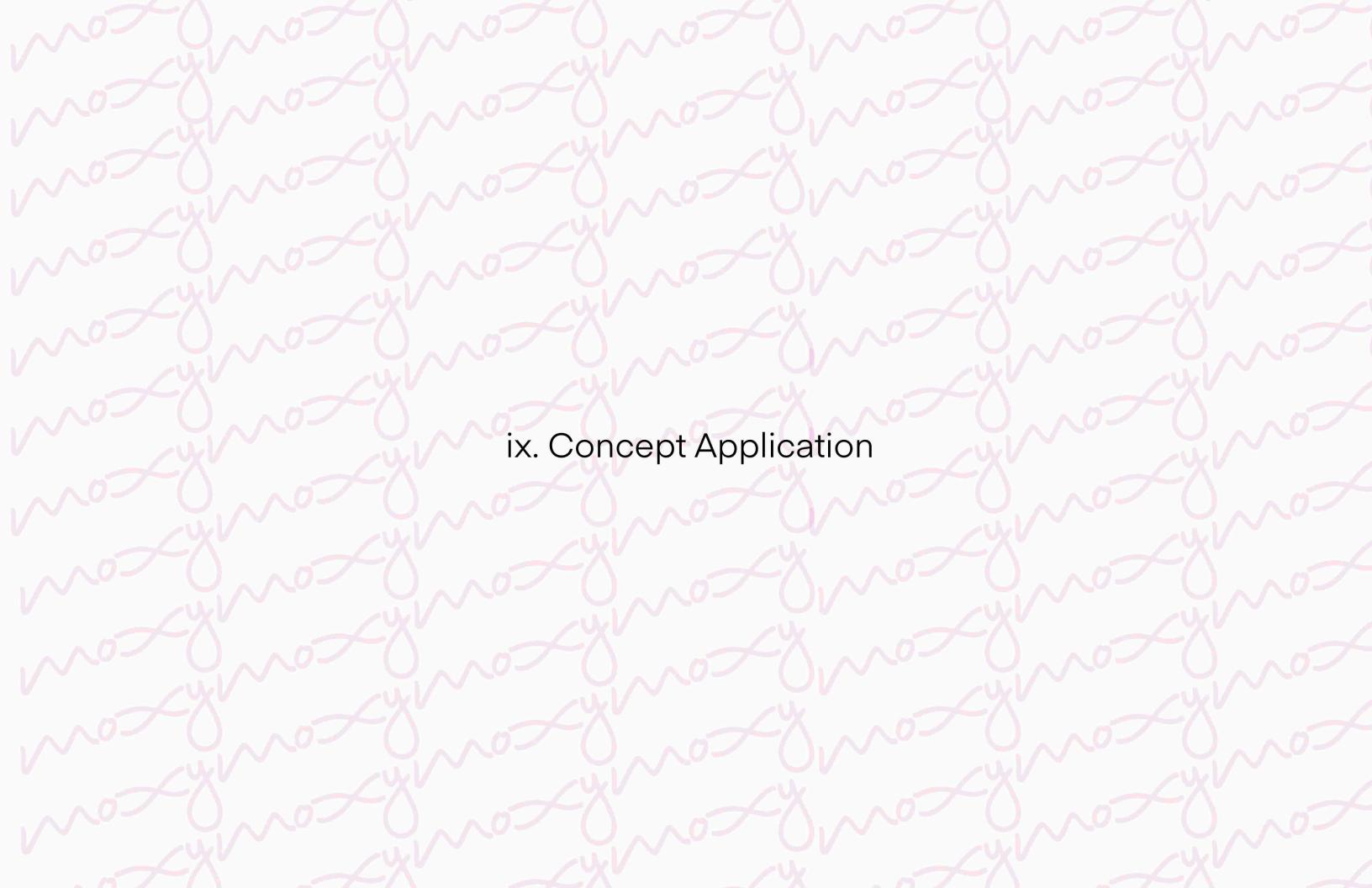


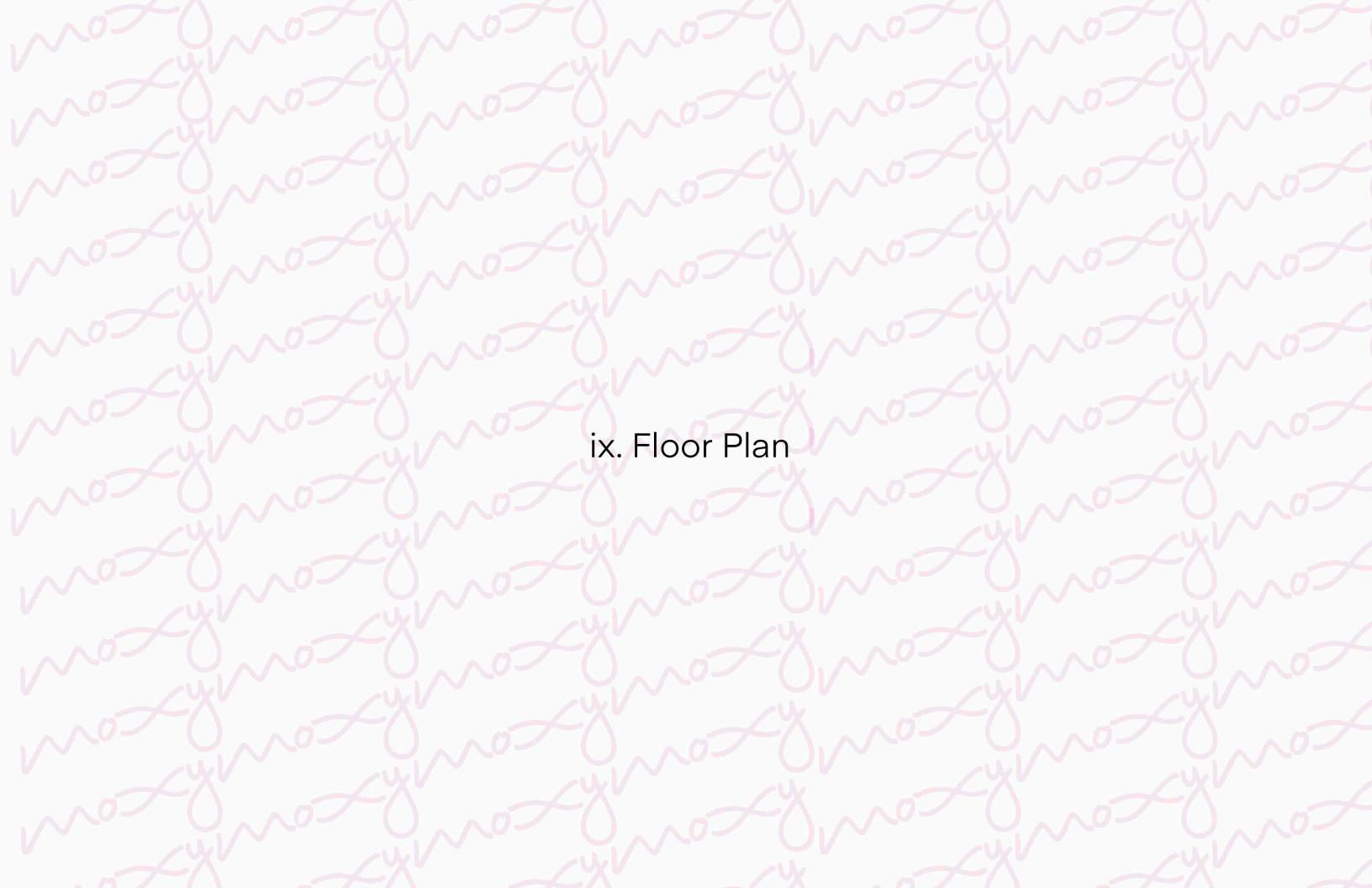
