The design of the workplace draws elements from Australia's natural setting. It is seamless and masterfully done.



Closed v. Open

Closed: Conference rooms are closed off from the rest of the space by glazed glass and vertical grey strings, acting like a partition.



Open: The open plan office space is set near a series of large windows that wash the space in natural light.

Public v. Private

Private: Directly across the hall from the kitchenette is a pair of small focus rooms.




Public: Sharing the space with the kitchenette is an easily accessible wooden table intended for eating and informal meetings.








Schematic Furniture Plan










Circulation & Organization

As soon as the user enters the workspace, they are led straight through the reception area, passing all the private meeting spaces. The end of the hallway leads to the open office. The circulation of the office is laid out in a grid, allowing for easy travel.

Concept Application

A great way to dissect and view the concept through the lenses of the philosophy known as <u>wabi-sabi</u>.

Wabi-sabi is the thought of finding **beauty in every aspect of imperfection** in nature. It is the aesthetic of things in existence, which are "imperfect, impermanent, and incomplete".

— A set of natural materials and un-dyed fabrics are key aspects of a wabi-sabi space, such as jute, linen, reclaimed wood and timber. — Earthy and muted colors are the main palette behind a wabi-sabi inspired space. A balance between browns, greys, beiges, and greens.

Other important themes explored in this space include the architecture of humanism, the democraticatization of design, and design equity.

— Crafted and handmade pieces such as woven rugs and ceramics are key decorative elements, chosen for their meaning and history.




Enlarged Plan of Birdhouse Architecture Firm





