Please be aware that course and qualification prices from April 2025 will no longer include a physical certificate or skills card.

If physical certificates or cards are required they will be available for purchase separately through Quartzweb when booking the course, with options to buy certificates alone, cards alone or both. Costs will be £1 +vat per learner for a physical certificate or £5 +vat per learner for a physical skills card.

These will need to be ordered for all learners attending the course or qualification.

If individual learners want these they will be available after the course has been completed and certificated via their learner record in the Learner Portal, a cost of £5 +vat per physical certificate and £10 +vat per physical skills card, including postage and packing fees.
