Charitable Donation Guidelines

As a general rule, charitable funds may be used for the following requests; however each request will be evaluated on an individual basis.

- 1. Local civilian non-profit (501-c3) organizations.
- 2. National organizations requesting funds that will be used locally and will stay here.

As a general rule, charitable funds should NOT be used for the following requests; however each request will be evaluated on an individual basis. Organizations should be a 501-(c)(3).

- 1. For-profit organizations, to include: individual, family, or shareholder profit. 2. Other miscellaneous requests not of a charitable nature; to include, but not limited to sports team sponsorship, uniforms, costumes, decorations, and refreshments. 3. Organizations who have refused to help the military population.
- 4. Organizations who participate in "mass mailings".
