

Placemat - 14" x 18"

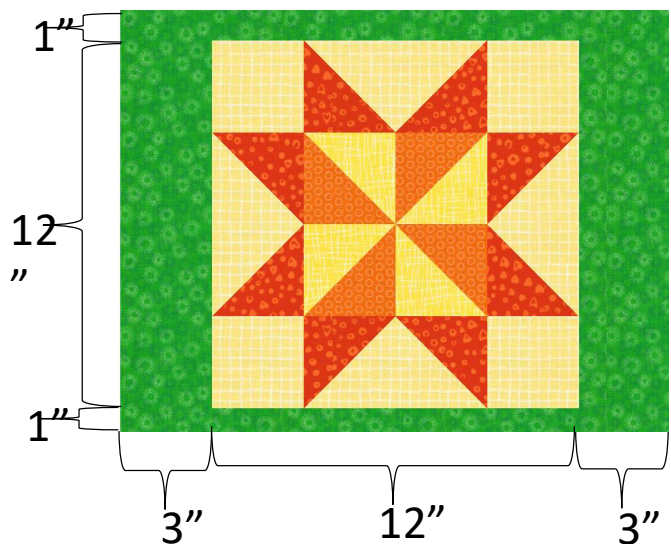
This instruction uses a 12" block with borders to make a 14" x 18" placemat.

If you have a 12" block in your UFO's that is looking for a purpose, this instruction provides a quick way to turn it into a useful item.

Requirements

- (1) 12½" (12" finished) block.
- (2) 3½" x 12½" border strips.
- (2) 1½" x 18½" border strips.
- (1) 16" x 20" backing
- (1) 16" x 20" batting
- 2 yards binding

1. Make a 12½" block (12" finished). If desired, you can use a print as the center.
2. Add the 3½" border strips to the side of the block.
3. Add 1½" border strips to the top and bottom.
4. Sandwich placemat, batting, and backing.
5. Quilt and bind.



Alternate border ideas:

For more creativity, try adding flying geese or half square triangles to the 3" side borders changes the design. *When making placemats, its OK to play with your food!* 🥰
