## QUILTED SCISSORS HOLDER TUTORIAL

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This version of the scissors holder features two layers of fabric quilted with thin batting, making it perfect for storing and protecting your favorite scissors or sewing tools. It's so super easy to make.

## Supplies:


1 81/2" x 11" plain piece of paper
Ruler and Pencil
Paper or craft scissors
Sewing machine with walking foot
Rotary cutter, mat, and clear acrylic ruler
Two fat quarters of fabric (one for each side of the scissor/tool holder)
One scrap of cotton batting 10" x 12"
Matching threads

Iron and ironing board


First, make the pattern for the scissor holder.

Start with the piece of paper. Fold the bottom edge to the left side as if you were making a paper airplane. Fold the creased edge again over to meet the left edge of the paper - and crease the folded edges well.

Then fold again to get a total of 4 sections on the paper.



Fold it back together and fold the bottom point up to touch the edge of the paper. Cut that part off. That will make a square bottom for the point of the scissors.



Layout the batting, then the fabric right sides together. Cut following the pattern after adding the 1/4 seam allowance. So the fabric is bigger than the pattern on every side.



Sew fabric and batting around the edges, leaving the opening for turning on the left side as shown.

Trim corners and batting. Turn, push corners to make good points, and press well.

Sew a narrow seam around the outside edge. This will close the opening from turning.

Once it is pressed, quilt it to keep the layers together. It is a funny shape so use your imagination and have fun with the quilting.



Now set the quilted item on top of the pattern. Use the folds on the pattern to set folds in the scissor holder. Press well.



Stitch each section together to the back starting with the left side. Then fold the remaining sides and press. Finally sew from the top of the bottom side, down to the bottom, across the bottom and up the short side.
