SNAPPY EYEGLASS CASE INSTRUCTIONS

Required:

2 pieces of 3/4" metal tape x 3 inches per case batting 15 x 4.5 inches outside fabric 15 x 4.5 inches inside fabric 19 x 4.5 inches triangle (2) 2 inch squares masking tape or painter's tape Walking foot is helpful

- 1. cover each of the sharp ends of the metal tape measure with tape
- 2. fold the 2 inch squares into triangles. press and set aside
- 3. on the inside fabric (lining) fold then iron down 1/2 inch on each end
- 4. layer / sandwich / pin the inside 19" fabric (wrong side up), then center the batting and then the outside 15" fabric (right side up).
- 5. turn down the lining from each side . place triangle tab in center, press and sew down 1/8" from edge to secure the tabs (this will leave an opening for the metal tab to slide into)
- 6. fold entire piece in half with the lining on the outside, lining up the edges. Sew down 1/2" each side from the stitch line.
- 7. insert metal pieces into each end being careful to orient it so that the curve faces the outside of the glass case.
- 8. Sew each top of the sides closed. Zig zag stitch down each side.
- 9. Your choice to either box the bottoms (1/2"), round the bottom by tapering stitching or leave it as is.
- 10. turn inside out and press if desired
- ** Option to quilt the fabrics, or to machine applique design on outside, or to use some of your decorative stitches as a design
