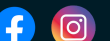

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Our Story

Jay Liesener was an adventurous and free-spirited individual known for his love of adrenaline and his outgoing personality. Despite a life-altering injury at 17 that left him a quadriplegic, Jay continued to live a full life by embracing his passion for surfing. He creatively modified a surfboard and organized a team of volunteers, known as Team Surfgimp, who helped him continue surfing. Over 15 years, the team became a close-knit community, traveling to surf in locations like Delaware, North Carolina, California, Puerto Rico and even Hawaii. They expanded their activities to snorkeling and hang gliding, always seeking new adventures.

As Jay's health declined in 2017, he and his team founded the Surfgimp Foundation, a charitable organization that supports people with disabilities in pursuing their dreams of an active lifestyle. Since its inception, the foundation has grown rapidly, providing grants and opportunities for countless individuals, continuing Jay's legacy of living life to the fullest despite physical limitations.
