2019 Grant Application Frequently Asked Questions

1. When and how can I apply for a grant?

The 2019 grant application will open October 15 and close on December 15, 2018. No applications will be accepted after the deadline. Applications should be submitted via email to info@teamsurfgimpfoundation.org. Although not preferred, applications can also be mailed to P.O. Box 5153 Arlington, VA 22205.

2. What is the procedure for applicant notification and grant distribution?

The grant committee will notify all applicants of their status via email the first week of January. Grantees will be invited to attend a fundraising event in January to receive their funds directly. If they are unable to attend, or choose to participate remotely (ie: Skype, video sent before the event etc.) a check will be mailed.

3. How can grant funds be used?

Surfgimp Foundation assists individuals with disabilities to participate in “limitless adventures” by awarding grant funding to help cover the cost of equipment, travel, lodging, support personnel/caregivers, admission/entry fees etc. so they can participate in activities of their choosing.

4. Is the Surfgimp Foundation Grant only available for surfing?

No! Although inspired by an adaptive surfer, the Foundation will consider applications for many types of adaptive sports and other activities.

5. What are reasons a grant application could be denied?

Applications that are not complete, lack detail or do not convey a clear need may not be considered for approval. In addition, if funds are not available, grants will be denied.

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
