

Parrot Head Club gives \$12,400 to Surfjimp Foundation

The Delaware Seashore Parrot Head Club presented a check for \$12,395 to the Surfjimp Foundation Aug. 16, at the Wheelhouse in Lewes. The donation was the largest in club history. An additional \$1,000 was donated to Children's Beach House in Lewes and to Lewes Presbyterian Church for its Community Thanksgiving Dinner.

The money was raised at the club's annual Boat Drinks Bacchanal, a fundraiser for Kent and Sussex county charities. More than 350 parrot heads attended this years event in May at Northbeach in Dewey Beach.
