



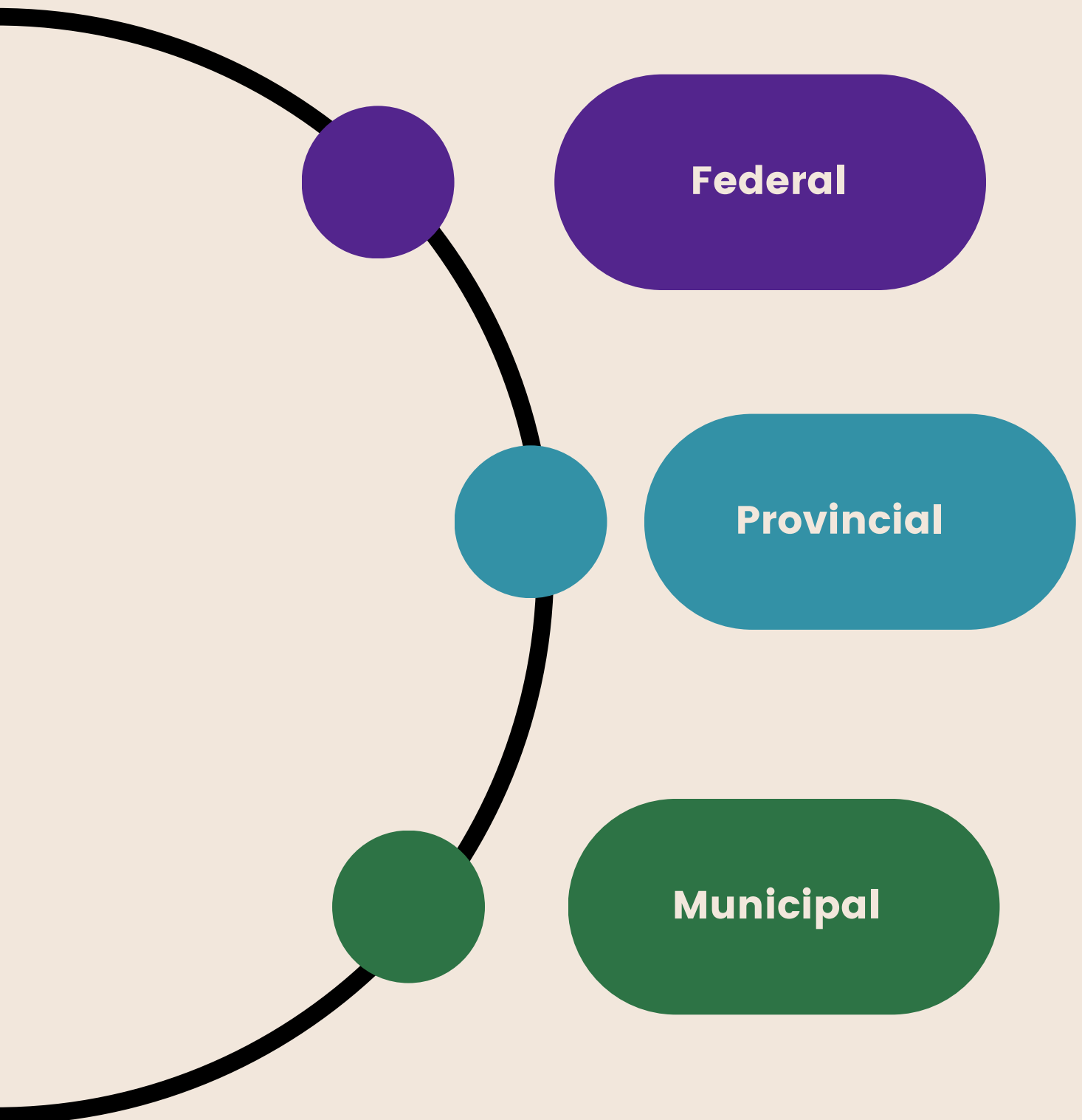

Federal Grants



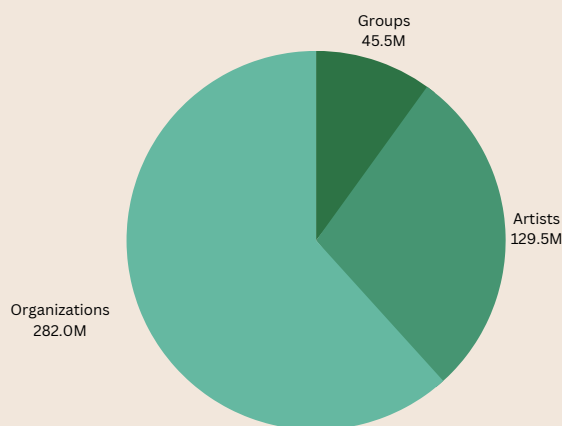
The federal government, the national government of Canada, offers a variety of grant funding options for arts, music, film, and culture.

Canada Council for the Arts

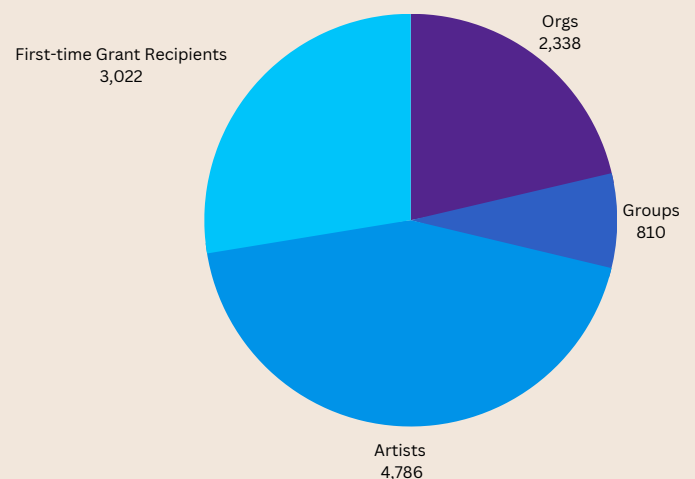


Canada Council for the Arts is a federal Crown corporation that offers grants in various disciplines like circus arts, media arts, visual arts, music & sound, Indigenous arts, deaf and disabled arts, literary arts, inter-disciplinary arts, and theatre.

Heritage Canada



Heritage Canada has various grant programs funding culture, history and sports. 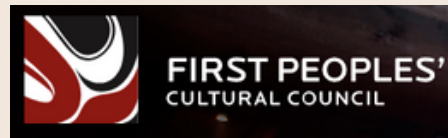
