1. CONSENT AGENDA*

a. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: March 7, 2026

A motion to approve the March Minutes was made by Councilor Butters, Councilor Barber seconded. Motion passed.

b. BILLS/PAYABLES: March Finance Report

A motion to approve March Finance Report was made by Councilor Cassel, Councilor Butters seconded. Motion passed.

c. SECOND QUARTER REPORT

Presented by city treasurer. A motion to approve the Second Quarter Report was made by Councilor Cassel, Councilor Barber seconded. Motion passed.

2. DEPARTMENT REPORTS

a. ROADS-Councilor Butters

Discussed trees along the county road that need to be removed. The county came up and also noticed the approach. If the city wanted to help out, the county would help with the approach to the city to prevent further damage. Road mix needs to be applied in some areas of town. Discussed other issues with roads. Digline will be up soon to mark utility lines. Council also discussed where some culverts need to be added.

b. BUILDING MAINTENANCE-Councilor Barber

Councilor Barber would like the buildings open by Memorial Day. Lawn mowers need to be pulled out and repaired/tuned-up. Phoebe brought up painting. Mayor Snyder would like bird spikes to be added to buildings so the mud swallows don't move back in. Council discussed maintenance on the buildings and getting some quotes.

c. IRRIGATION-Mayor Snyder

Mayor Snyder is hoping for the 1st of May to have irrigation on. Idaho Power needs to come up and get power going. Council discussed some problems that could occur and some accounts that need to be locked out.

d. HISTORICAL-Councilor Barber

Treasurer-Phoebe Cassel-none at this time.

Historical will be meeting again next Saturday. They will be looking at buildings and see what needs to be done. There were some questions about who will be on the commission.

e. CEMETERY-Councilor Cassel

Councilor Cassel would like to get a work party to clean up the cemetery. Discussed having community justice and a naval group come up to help out. Mayor Snyder will start felling some smaller trees. There was a question about dying trees.

3. NEW BUSINESS

a. All Hazard Mitigation Plan-Councilor Barber

Presented by Councilor Barber for Council to consider next month to approve. Also, discussed a map showing hazards for the next three months regarding wildfires.

4. OLD BUSINESS

a. Fire Prevention Ordinance*

New wording was presented. A motion to approve the Fire Prevention Ordinance was made by Councilor Barber, Councilor Butters seconded. Councilor Cassel abstained. Motion passed.

b. Historic District Building Codes* nothing at this time.
