EASY APPLE COBBLER

Warm apples and cinnamon roll bites with sweet frosting? Yes, please! This wonderful apple cobbler is so incredibly easy to make with just three ingredients, you'll be wowed.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1. Pillsbury refrigerated cinnamon rolls use the original rolls, not Grands.
- 2. Apple pie filling
- Cinnamon the cinnamon is option as there is already cinnamon in the rolls and pie filling, but a little extra fresh cinnamon really bumps up the flavor.

DIRECTIONS:

In a mixing bowl, stir together the cinnamon roll pieces, apple pie filling, and ground cinnamon. Pour the mixture into a greased 2-quart baking dish.

Bake the cobbler at 375°F for 20-25 minutes until golden brown and the rolls are cooked through. Remove the pan from the oven and spoon the frosting from the cinnamon roll package over top of the hot cobbler.

Cool the cobbler slightly before serving. If serving for dessert, you might want to add a scoop of vanilla bean ice cream into the hot cobbler with a drizzle of caramel sauce.

Cruise-ins are a lot less formal and mostly entail a smaller group of people gathering at a park or a parking lot for a few hours with no fee involved.


Don't be critical
