## Letter from the President

Happy New Year!

As the New Year starts, we are home just wishing for Spring to come around and cruise-in season to start. A time to contemplate all the good things that we can do with these wonderful classic vehicles. Car shows, cruise-ins, power tours, and attending other vehicle related things, all the fun things.

The 42nd Annual Cabin Fever Car & Motorcycle Show in Knoxville, TN, is scheduled for January 9-11, 2026, at the Knoxville Expo Center, with hours from 5 PM-8 PM Friday, 8 AM-8 PM Saturday, and 8 AM-4 PM Sunday. The main Hamblen County car show, the "Winter Angel Expo," is scheduled for January 17-18, 2026, at the Great Smoky Mountain Expo Center in White Pine, TN, featuring classic cars, trucks, motorcycles, and more. So these are a good way to start the year.

This year we need to dedicate more time to the Mossy Creek Cruzers. Try to get more people interested in joining our club, attend more meetings regularly the first Tuesday of each month at Shoney's in Dandridge (6:30 pm) and volunteer at the two car shows. Attend our Friday night cruise-in at College Square Shopping Center (Big Lots). The number of cruise-ins per month will soon be determined.

Again it is time to publish our book, This may not seem important to some members, but we raise more charity money with this book than we do at our two car shows. We usually clear, after printing expenses, approximately \$7,500. If members would sell just one advertisement, it would take a lot of time and effort off of the three or four that do sell. If you need the ad price list, a list of who we donate to, copy of our non-profit through the government, 501(C)3 form, receipt forms for customers and one for the club, just let me know and I will supply them to you. Let's make this the best book ever!!

How to sell ads: It is very easy. Always ask for the owner or the manager. Explain to them that most of the money that the club makes goes to local charities. Last year it was over \$11,000! Show them the list of who we donate to and a copy of the 2025 book. We print 3,000 to 3,500 books each year and they will receive a stack of the books to give out as well as the ones we give out at car shows and cruise-ins. Be sure to get good artwork and what they want their ad to say to give to me for placement in the book. Ask if they need us to email a proof of their ad to them. The best places to ask for ads: restaurants, auto supply and repair places, barber/beauty shops, furniture stores, banks, doctors/dentists, heating and cooling companies, well diggers, police departments, real estate, vape and package stores, hardware, funeral homes, drug stores, flea markets, auctions, motorcycle shops, bakeries, pet spas, pizza cafes, campgrounds, marinas, tractor repair, jewelers, rv services. mercantiles, flooring, lawn care, tire stores, wrecker and towing companies, auto sales, chamber of commerce, tool guys, printing companies, and pawn shops. This is just a few suggestions. We need some new ads this year to give the book a fresher look, although our regular customers are special! Most people are glad to help out when they hear it is about charities, especially local charities. Please try to help out your club this year.

About my health: I am now doing dialysis, three times a week, 4 hours each time. That is an extremely long time to have to give up. The good thing is that I feel so much better! Thank y'all for all the prayers that have come my way.

## Meeting Minutes – January 6

The minutes from the last meeting were published in the newsletter.

Pat thanked Bob and Linda for hosting the MCC Christmas Party in their home. It was a nice party for the 28 members and guests who attended.

Pat reviewed the process for selling advertisements in our program books. Ad sizes and prices, and a copy of our 501C letter, were handed out. Her health will not allow her to be involved selling as much as she has in the past and asked for volunteers. Pete recommended that we call first and let them know we are coming to minimize the number of trips to each establishment. This topic concluded with a discussion on members placing ads for their vehicles. This is allowed at the same published sizes/rates.

Committee Leader Nominations/Elections were held:

Car Show Committee – Nominated: Doug Rodgers. Motion: Linda L. 2nd: John M.

Chaplin – Nominated: Jackie Swank. Motion: Jackie. 2nd: Pete B.

Membership – Nominated: Pat Dukes. Motion: Bobby. 2nd: Linda L.

All were approved. They take office immediately.

Note that the Charities Committee was not filled as it is subject to being eliminated in the upcoming bylaws change and we did not have a candidate.

A Board of Directors meeting was scheduled for Monday, January 12 at the Texas Roadhouse in Morristown. The purpose is to finalize the bylaws that are currently under construction. Rick E. will contact the restaurant for a reservation for a table out of the main traffic flow.

Rick E. presented a sample of a 2026 calendar printed by the Hamblen County Car Club. The cars on the calendar belong to the members who are volunteering to work the upcoming Winter Angel Expo. They will be given to current members and the left overs sold at the 2026 shows or given as door prizes at the Saturday Night Cruise Ins. Custom Printing on Cumberland Street in Morristown did the printing. This was just an idea and a resource as Pat has been talking about making a MCC calendar.

The 2026 Cruise In Schedule was discussed. Pat delivered the assessment that the once a month schedule did not work very well and asked if we should go back to every Friday night? Pete B. added that the cruise ins are an important part of recruiting new members. Rick S. added we should invite other local clubs to our Cruise Ins. Bobby recommended we keep the existing schedule. Having a standard rain date (i.e. 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday) was discussed. No decision was made at this meeting.

Pat provided an update on her health. She is currently doing dialysis in Dandridge three days a week for four hours a day. While this is cramping her schedule, she is feeling good.

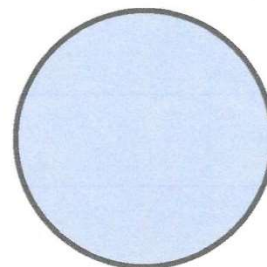
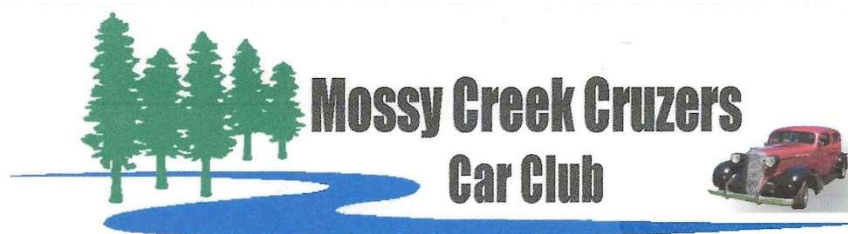
