COOL WHIP COOKIES

INGREDIENTS:

COOKIE DOUGH

- 1 (8 ounce) Cool Whip
- 1 Large Egg
- 1 Box cake mix, any flavor

COATING

1 cup powdered sugar

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- Mix all cookie dough ingredients together well.

Put powdered sugar into a bowl or zipper bag.

Drop about a Tablespoon of dough at a time into the powdered sugar and coat as you gently form balls and to coat the balls.

Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

Place the coated balls about 2" apart on the parchment paper.

Bake for 14 minutes. Immediately cool on wire rack.

MAKES:

2-3 dozen cookies (depending on size). PREP TIME: 10 Min. COOK TIME: 15 Min.
