MARCH 2015 Minutes

HELP...I HAVE FALLEN

CRUZER LOIS SHELTON

JEFFERSON CITY -- Lois Shelton is socially savvy with the computer - with plenty of posts, likes, and friends on her Facebook page. "I've wondered if I was the oldest person on Facebook," Shelton said inside her home, admitting she did not expect to be home following a medical scare last week. Channel 10 came out and interviewed Lois. "I knew I would've been laying on this floor for at least two weeks before anybody found me." Last Thursday evening, Shelton was walking to her kitchen when she fell over steps and hit the floor. "I don't know what happened to my arm, but I couldn't lift it and couldn't get up," she recalled. Her cell phone was across the hall in the living room. She could not get to it. Just feet away, though, was her computer. "I got a hold of my keyboard, and I pulled it down into the floor...with one hand, I was able to type, "help, I need help. I have fallen." Within minutes, friends on the social media site posted on her wall, asking if she needed help. One of her friends got in touch with Lois' neighbors, Cecil and Betty "Lois' daughter-in-law

called us and saw on Facebook where she had fallen. I said I'll run up there and see what's wrong," Cecil Pierce said. The couple had keys to Lois's house. When they entered, the Pierces found Shelton on the floor. They called 911

immediately for help. "When they left the house, Cecil's sister from Oklahoma called and asked how Lois was doing," Pierce added. "She saw it on Facebook in Oklahoma, so she wanted to know." Shelton ended up with a large bruise, and she will need further testing to see if there is any other damage. "I had such a fear that it would be two weeks until someone found me," Shelton said. "(My Facebook friends) said it was unreal." Thanks to them!
