We also have an opening for the **Membership Coordinator**. This individual is responsible for promoting membership, collecting dues, and working with the community as a Club representative. This is a great role for an outgoing person who loves to meet and talk to people.

Finally, we need more specific operational help on our **Car Show Committee**, including distributing program books, putting up signs, and working at the activities (registration, silent auction, envelope board, etc.) on the day of the event.

Most of these positions only require up to two hours per month and someone will be available to help until you feel comfortable with the role and process.





Meeting Minutes - August 5



Pat Dukes called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm. She welcomed the 20 members in attendance. Bob Latham lead the opening prayer, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Bob provided the Treasurer's report:

Beginning Balance: \$10,496.62, Activity: -\$3,244.52. Ending Balance: \$13,741.18.

Jackie made a motion to accept. Seconded by John. Motion passed.

Bob provided breakdown of show income. Registration = \$2,040, Envelopes = \$1,260, Silent Auction = \$1078, Floating Dock Raffle = \$316, Vendors = \$270, Donations for 2 Children = \$191, and T-Shirts = \$155. The silent auction had expenses or approximately \$700. Not all invoices for show expenses have been received. 35 people worked the show. A motion to round up the Donations for the Children to \$200 was made by Bobby Estes, seconded by everyone and approved. Note that checks to charitable organizations will be made in November.

Car show improvement ideas were briefly discussed by the group. These included updating the show flyer, allowing more room for show car entrance to ease backing up onto the road, moving the registration tent, trophy classes, compilation of judging forms and announcement of the winners, and member parking. Vic recommended that member cars be parked with the show cars. A motion to do so was made by Jackie and seconded by Bob. All approved. This change will allow club members to compete for trophies providing independent (non-member) judges are used. Pat thanked the judges who worked the July show.

The October show was also discussed. There will be two show planning meetings, both to be held on the last Tuesday of the month (August 26th and September 30th) at 6:00 pm at Perkins in Dandridge. Silent auction items are a concern. It is requested for everyone to bring one item to the next club meeting on September 2nd. Doug is reorganizing the trailer. Pat needs all signs with dates back for a date change.

Bobby shared the details of the club picnic which will be held, along with the Lakeway Mustang Club and the F-100 Owners Club, on Saturday, August 23rd at 5:00 pm. See article above.

Bobby also reviewed upcoming Power Tour events. See the event calendar in this newsletter, or on our website, for up to date information. A motion to hold a special "Trunk & Treat" Cruise In on Thursday, October 30 at Big Lots in Jefferson City was made by Oscar. Linda seconded it. Approved.

A motion to adjourn was made by Linda. It was seconded by Chris and approved. The meeting ended at 7:40 pm.
