Meeting Minutes – February 3



Pat Dukes called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. She welcomed the nine members in attendance. Bob Latham gave the opening prayer, and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bob L. provided the Treasurer's report:

Beginning Balance: \$8,271.74, Activity: \$2,830.12, Ending Balance: \$11,101.86.

The increase in activity was due to the selling of ads for our Program Books. Bobby E. made a motion to accept the report. 2nd by John M. Motion passed. Bob commented that the \$4,000 collected in January as a record. Over one half of last year's ads have been sold.

The minutes from the last meeting were published in the newsletter.

Rick E presented the final changes to the by-laws that were approved by the Board of Directors in January. Bob L. made a motion to accept the revised by-laws. 2nd by Phil. Motion passed.

We still have one open seat on our Board of Directors due to the resigning of Rick Swank. Pat asked John Moody if he would be interested and he said yes. Bob L. made a motion to nominate John to the position. 2nd by Bobby E. Motion passed. For those who do not know John, he is an active member, seen frequently at Club meetings and events, and the President of the Lakeway Mustang Club.

Bob L. made the recommendation for a charity committee to manage who we will make charitable contributions to. That committee however, was just removed from the by-laws because it had gone unstaffed. The new process, outlined in the by-laws, places the responsibility on the Club Officers.

Pat will recommend a firehouse in Newport be added to the list of this year's recipients. The process to update the list of organizations begins in September.

Pat read a very nice thank you letter received from Isaiah 1:17 for our 2025 contribution to them.

Our October Car Show held at Bush Beans in Dandridge has been confirmed for October 10th, which is the second Saturday. The second Saturday has been reserved for the next 5 years. Pat is in the process of designing the T-shirt designs for this year's shows.

Bobby E. is working on the Power Tour dates and destinations. So far, March and April have been confirmed. See the details in the Upcoming Events column in this newsletter. May and June are under construction. Bulls Gap Cruise Ins have been scheduled for 2026, but many are in conflict with other area events. Phil asked where these events can be seen. Bobby indicated that these are all on Facebook.

Our Club Secretary has not shown up at the last few meetings, so Pat will give her a call.

A motion to adjourn was made at 7:30 by John M. 2nd by Bobby E. Approved.

Operating Committee Leaders

Article Six of our by-laws states: The members shall nominate and elect the following positions:

Car Show Director(s) – *Doug Rodgers*

This individual organizes a committee to conduct any car shows sponsored by the Club. The position requires commitment to the club through promotion, advertisement, participant involvement, and public relations.

Communications Coordinator – *Rick Elder*

This individual shall be responsible for writing, editing, and maintaining a monthly newsletter for the Club and distributing it to members and other clubs. Position also includes publicity and maintains the club's website.

Membership Coordinator – *Pat Dukes*

This individual is responsible for promoting membership, collecting dues, and working with the community as a Club representative. They must maintain a membership roster of all member types.

Chaplin – *Open*

This individual leads all meetings with a prayer. They check on member's health and family situations and sends flowers/cards or appropriate condolences when required.

The MCC Car Club Newsletter is an official publication of the Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club. It is created and distributed electronically each month. All news articles, photographs, and items of interest are welcome for consideration for publication, but subject to editing. Submission deadline is the date of the MCC monthly meeting. Members who do not have email may receive the newsletter by snail mail upon request.

By-Laws Update

The MCC Car Club By-laws is a “living” document that outlines the constitution and administration of the club. It must be consistently updated to ensure that they represent guidelines for how the club operates (saying what we do) and auditing that club leaders are working within those guidelines (doing what we say). Changes were recognized in the existing document, and a new draft was created.

The Board of Directors met on Tuesday, November 25 to review changes against the current document and the new draft. The following changes were made at that time (see December 2025 newsletter).

- Members. We added member statuses and a new section for removing an active member.
- Board of Directors. The number of BOD members and the role of the President as part of the board were discussed. The total number of BOD members, including the President and Past President, must be odd. Because it is not currently, one additional director will be added immediately. The President has the same rights as other BOD members.
- Election Process. All Board of Director, Club Officers, and Committee Leaders are nominated and elected. There are none appointed. Processes for all three levels were discussed and updated.
- Duties of stated roles were discussed and updated.
 - The Charities Committee was eliminated. Two new by-laws articles states the charitable giving process to organizations and another to individuals and families.
 - The Public Relations position was put under communications.
 - A new Events Committee to manage cruise in production and fun runs was added.
- Many minor changes eliminating redundancy and making the document more readable.

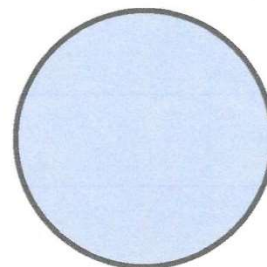
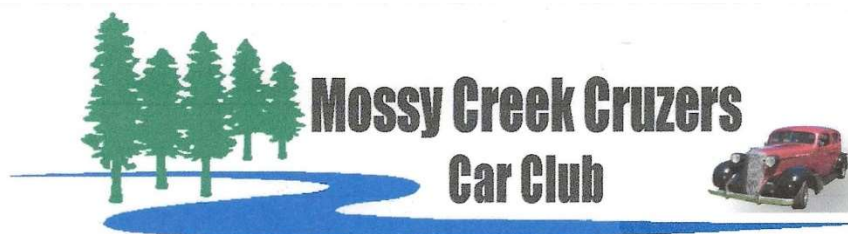
A follow-up meeting of the Board of Directors took place on Monday, January 12th to complete the review of Articles Seven through Eleven. This is a summary of the balance of the document.

- It was decided not to add an Event Committee. Redundancies were removed.
- New – Article EIGHT: Donations to Charitable Organizations was added. This article defines a charitable organization and captures the process that Bob L. used this past year, but adds more specific timing. Emergency distributions are limited to \$500.
- New – Article NINE: Donations to Individuals and Families was added. This article specifies the process for helping club members and their families in need. Emergency distributions are limited to \$500.
- Article TEN – Specifies that a quorum (majority) of BOD members will be required for any by-laws changes.

These changes were approved by the BOD on January 13th.

These were reviewed and discussed at the February meeting and voted on by the membership. They will go into effect immediately and will be posted publicly on our web site.

Just one final note on the By-laws. It is up to every member, whether a Club Officer or not, to hold our leaders accountable for following the by-laws document. Likewise as a volunteer leader, you must understand the by-laws and govern according to them. That does not mean we cannot have fun. It just means we must honor and respect the guidelines established for the Club.
