

That makes the classes so worth while, because that is what the Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club is all about, helping our community.

On July 9th, the original Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club, presents their 6th annual car show at Jefferson Middle School, on Highway 11-E in Jefferson City, from 9:00 am until 3:00 pm. This is the major car show of the year and the charities they support are local Special Olympics, Children's Hospital and the scholarships that they give to students from Jefferson County High School and Cops with Kids, which takes underprivileged children shopping at Walmart for Christmas. Other charities throughout the year benefit from the charity fund of the club. Fifties and sixties music will be played during the day and lots of activities including 50-50 tickets, cake walks, piston toss, silent auction, fan belt toss, poker walks and guess how many pieces of candy in a jar. There will be barbeque and hamburgers and hot dogs available for purchase, so come hungry and support our vendors.

This year the Cruzers are having a craft show in conjunction to the car show. Come and see the handmade items as well as direct sale items. This is new to the car show and we hope to make it bigger and better each year. For more info call Pat at the phone number below.

The Cruzers host another car show in October (date not set yet) called Fill the Truck with Toys. The fee to register a vehicle into the show is to bring a new, unwrapped toy to donate. These toys are then donated to Christmas in Jefferson County who gives toys to underprivileged children who otherwise would not have a Christmas gift. It is held in the front yard of the American Legion in Jefferson City.
